


CONSENT ORDER

 - ii. The Respondent's mortgage loan originator license renewal fee was not paid on or before December 1, 2013.
 - iii. The Respondent has failed to pay the late license renewal fees of \$280.00.

- (2) The Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order.
- (3) The Respondent agrees to pay the \$280.00 late license renewal fees and a \$100.00 civil penalty, payable to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, on or before September 11, 2014.
- (4) The payment shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 14-0176-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of Roy John Martin, General Counsel, Department of Consumer Credit, 3613 N.W. 56th Street, Suite 240, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112.
- (5) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned by United States mail to the Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Fredit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Create.
- (6) If the Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Pepartment of Consumer Credit is authorized to file in application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions 59 O.S. § 2095.17(c).
