CONSENT ORDER

Petitioner, State of Oklahoma *ex rel.* Department of Consumer Credit ("Petitioner") and Respondent, Tom's Pawns LLC, ("Respondent") voluntarily enter into this Consent Order as an informal disposition of this individual proceeding to avoid litigation. Respondent agrees to waive its right to a hearing under the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act and both parties agree as follows:

(1) Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter.

a. Respondent is a domestic limited liability company in the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma Secretary of State filing number 3512097307, active filing status.

b. Respondent transacts business at 3128 N. May Ave., Oklahoma City, OK 73112.

c. Respondent was licensed as a pawnbroker in the State of Oklahoma, license number PB001622. Said license expired December 31, 2018.

d. On March 8, 2019, Respondent was served an Emergency Order and Notice of Hearing by Angela Gober, Consumer Credit Examiner. Respondent was ordered to cease and desist pawnbroker activity until Respondent obtained the proper license. After serving the Emergency Order on Respondent, Ms. Gober requested Respondent provide her with a list of

all pawn and buy transactions entered into by Respondent from January 1, 2019 to March 8, 2019. It was determined that Respondent had 167 active pawns, 140 redeemed pawns, 2 pulled pawns and 61 buys between January 1, 2019 and March 8, 2019.

e. On March 26, 2019, Petitioner received a pawnbroker license application from Respondent. On April 1, 2019, Petitioner issued Respondent a new pawnbroker license, license number PB001926 which is effective through December 31, 2019.

(2) Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter, and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order, except that Respondent admits the facts necessary to establish the Department's jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter of this action.

(3) Respondent agrees to pay a \$3,500.00 civil penalty, payable in 14 installments of \$250.00, with first installment payment of \$250.00 due on or before September 16, 2019, and subsequent installment payments of \$250.00 due on or before the 16th of the month for 13 months thereafter.

(4) The payments shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 19-0233-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of John T. Coyne, Chief Enforcement Counsel, Department of Consumer Credit, 3613 N.W. 56th Street, Suite 240, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112.

(5) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned to Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.

(6) If Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 2095.17(c).

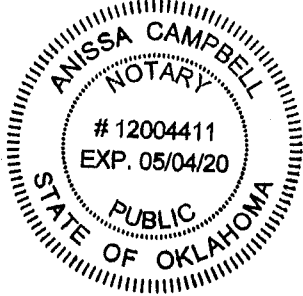
