CONSENT ORDER

Petitioner, State of Oklahoma *ex rel.* Department of Consumer Credit ("Petitioner") and Respondent, BM Collectibles LLC, ("Respondent") voluntarily enter into this Consent Order as an informal disposition of this individual proceeding to avoid litigation. Respondent agrees to waive its right to a hearing under the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act and both parties agree as follows:

(1) Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter.

i. Respondent is a domestic limited liability company under the jurisdiction of the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma Secretary of State filing number 3513214584, active filing status.

ii. Respondent is located at 841 S. Mustang Rd., Yukon, OK 73099.

iii. On July 14, 2026, Jimmie Ray and Michael Thompson, Consumer Credit Investigators, arrived at Respondent's location and spoke with Bill Patterson, the owner. The Investigators requested to see purchase tickets, and Mr. Patterson stated that he did not have any purchase tickets for gold or precious metals. Mr. Patterson stated he has only been in business for about three weeks. The Investigators took photographs of the signs outside of

Respondent's building that stated, "We Buy Gold", "We Buy Silver" and "Cash 4 Gold".

iv. As of the date of the Notice and Order of Hearing, Respondent was not licensed as a precious metal and gem dealer.

v. On August 4, 2026, Petitioner received a Precious Metal and Gem Dealer license application from Respondent. License number PM007778 was issued to Respondent on August 5, 2026.

(2) Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice and Order of Hearing filed in this matter, and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order, except that Respondent admits the facts necessary to establish the Department's jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter of this action.

(3) Respondent agrees to pay a civil penalty of \$1,500.00 (fifteen hundred dollars), payable to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit in three (3) payments of \$500.00, with first payment of \$500.00 due on or before August 27, 2026, second payment of \$500.00 due on or before September 27, 2026, and third payment of \$500.00 due on or before October 27, 2026.

(4) The payments shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 26-0086-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of John T. Coyne, Chief Enforcement Counsel, Department of Consumer Credit, 629 NE 28th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105.

(5) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned to Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.

(6) If Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 1528(H).
