CONSENT ORDER

Petitioner, State of Oklahoma *ex rel.* Department of Consumer Credit ("Petitioner") and Respondent, Grubbs Automotive ATUL, LLC d/b/a Grubbs Acura of Tulsa, ("Respondent") voluntarily enter into this Consent Order as an informal disposition of this individual proceeding to avoid litigation. Respondent agrees to waive its right to a hearing under the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act and both parties agree as follows:

(1) Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter.

i. Respondent is a foreign limited liability company under the jurisdiction of the State of Texas, Oklahoma Secretary of State filing number 3713173312; active filing status.

ii. Respondent transacts business at 4905 S. Memorial Dr., Tulsa, OK 74145.

iii. On April 15, 2026, Consumer Credit Investigators Jimmie Ray and Michael Thompson, arrived at Respondent's location and spoke to Al Lewis, General Manager. Upon request, the Investigators reviewed and scanned executed retail installment sale contracts. The review of one retail installment sale contract listed Respondent as the seller with financing terms of 8.39% interest with the amount

financed as \$43,998.00 and monthly payments of \$758.45 for 75 months. The loan was assigned to Ally Bank. A review of Respondent's website shows consumers can apply for pre-approval financing.

iv. A review of Petitioner's database shows Respondent had a Notification license, license number 89457 which expired on January 31, 2026.

v. As of the date of the Notice, Respondent was not licensed in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to the provisions of 14A O.S. §§ 6-201 through 6-203 of the UCCC. 14A O.S. § 6-203(2).

vi. Petitioner received a Notification license application and filing fee from Respondent on June 11, 2026. License #89899 was issued on June 11, 2026.

(2) Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter, and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order, except that Respondent admits the facts necessary to establish the Department's jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter of this action.

(3) Respondent agrees to pay a civil penalty of \$500.00, payable to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, on or before July 2, 2026.

(4) The payment shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 26-0073-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of John T. Coyne, Chief Enforcement Counsel, Department of Consumer Credit, 629 NE 28th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105.

(5) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned to Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.

(6) If Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 2095.17(c).



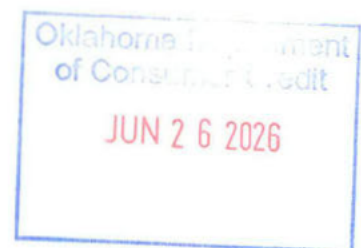
