Petitioner, State of Oklahoma ex rel. Department of Consumer Credit ("Petitioner") and Respondent, Campbell Health and Wellness Solutions LLC, d/b/a Hotworx (Tahlequah), ("Respondent") voluntarily enter into this Consent Order as an informal disposition of this individual proceeding to avoid litigation. Respondent hereby waives service of process and instead received Notice and Order of Hearing via email. Respondent agrees to waive its right to a hearing and both parties agree as follows:

(1) Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter.

i. Respondent is a domestic limited liability company under the jurisdiction of the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma Secretary of State filing number 3513026700, inactive filing status.

ii. Respondent transacts business at 403-B Daisy Drive, Tahlequah, OK 74464.

iii. On September 4, 2025, Jimmie Ray and Michael Thompson, Consumer Credit Investigators, visited Respondent's location and spoke to Amber Campbell, Owner. Ms. Campbell stated Respondent has been open since March 1, 2025, and Respondent's corporate name is Campbell Health & Wellness Solutions LLC. Ms. Campbell advised that members can sign

up online at Respondent's website. Upon request, the Investigators reviewed and copied an executed membership agreement which showed the member pays \$49.00 per month and must fulfill an initial term of 6 full billing cycles with an initial enrollment fee of \$15. If the member cancels before the end of the initial term, the member will be liable for a \$99-dollar early cancellation fee. Respondent is engaged in a program of physical exercise, which includes the weight-lifting room, exercising machine, engaged in the sale of the right or privilege to use exercise equipment or facilities. A review of Petitioner's database shows Respondent does not have a Health Spa license with Petitioner.

iv. As of the date of the Notice and Order of Hearing, Respondent was operating without a Health Spa License.

v. On May 8, 2026, Petitioner received a Health Spa license application and filing fee from Respondent.

(2) Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter, and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order, except that Respondent admits the facts necessary to establish the Department's jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter of this action.

(3) Respondent agrees to pay a civil penalty of \$2,500.00, plus reimbursement for the \$699.00 process service fee incurred by the Department, for a total of \$3,199.00 payable to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, on or before May 28, 2026.

(4) The payment shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 25-0120-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of John T. Coyne, Chief Enforcement Counsel, Department of Consumer Credit, 629 NE 28th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105.

(5) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned to Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.

(6) If Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this

Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 2095.17(c).
