CONSENT ORDER

(1) Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter.

ii. Respondent transacts business at 100 E. Main Street, Weatherford, OK 73096.

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Basic" which showed a 6-month initial term, payment of \$49.00 per month, and an initial enrollment fee of \$49.50. The agreement stated that if the member cancels before the end of the initial term, the member will be liable for a \$99.00 early cancellation fee. Respondent is engaged in a program of physical exercise, which includes the weight-lifting room, exercising machine, engaged in the sale of the right or privilege to use exercise equipment or facilities. A review of Petitioner's database shows Respondent did not have a Health Spa license with Petitioner.

iv. As of the date of the Notice and Order of Hearing, Respondent was operating without a Health Spa License.

v. On December 19, 2025, Petitioner received a Health Spa license application and filing fee from Respondent. License number SPA00909 was issued to Respondent on December 30, 2025.

(2) Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter, and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order, except that Respondent admits the facts necessary to establish the Department's jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter of this action.

(3) Respondent agrees to pay a civil penalty of \$1,250.00, payable to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, on or before February 5, 2026.

(4) The payment shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 25-0116-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of John T. Coyne, Chief Enforcement Counsel, Department of Consumer Credit, 629 NE 28th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105.

(5) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned to Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.

(6) If Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this

Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma
in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 2095.17(c).
