

The Oklahoma Department of Rehabilitation Services (DRS) and OU Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) invites its Transition clients to participate in the BEST STEP Summer Programs.



We will try to match your job with your career area of interest (e.g., working in an office, food service, retail, manufacturing, construction, law enforcement, aviation, medical, oil/gas, animals).

You'll have the opportunity to work part-time up to 25 hours per week for a business in your community in an area of your interest and earn a paycheck.
