# Call Today for *Community - Based Care*

Living Choice offers an array of community-based services that can help make the move a successful one:

- Case Management
- Home-delivered meals
- Transportation
- Skilled nursing
- Physical Therapy
- Personal care
- Medication management
- Daily Living Supports
- Habilitation Training Specialist Services
- Supported Employment
- Prevocational Services
- Transitional funds up to \$3,000 to help facilitate the move
- Additional service may be available depending on your needs

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- Ages 19 years and older.
- Must qualify for SoonerCare for at least one day before the move.
- Have lived in an institutional setting for at least 60 consecutive days.
- Must voluntarily want to transition back into the community and play an active role in their personal care plan.

**Transitions begin with a call to Oklahoma's Living Choice program, or visit our webpage and complete the intake form.**
