Living Choice offers an array of community-based services that can help make the move a successful one:

- · Assistance with finding a new residence
- Home-delivered meals
- Transportation
- Skilled nursing
- Physical Therapy
- Personal care

Eligibility Requirements

• Ages 19 years and older.

- Medication management
 - Transitional funds up to \$2,400 to help facilitate the move
 - Additional service may be available depending on your needs

- Must qualify for SoonerCare for at least one day before the move.
- Have lived in an institutional setting for at least 60 consecutive days.
- Must voluntarily want to transition back into the community and play an active role in their personal care plan.

Referrals by a family member, physician or other interested party are also welcome.

Transitions begin with a call to Oklahoma's Living Choice program, or visit our webpage and complete the intake form. A referral can come from anyone.
