## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Pursuant to 447.205 of Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) is required to give public notice of any significant proposed change in methods and standards for setting payment rates for services in Oklahoma Medicaid program. The following rate change and methodology will necessitate an amendment to the Oklahoma Medicaid State Plan and agency rules. An Indian Health Service (IHS)/Tribal/Urban Indian (ITU) Notice was sent to inform tribal partners on August 23, 2024. The proposed changes were presented at the Tribal Consultation meeting September 3, 2024 at 11:00 a.m. via teleconference and were heard at the State Plan Amendment Rate Committee (SPARC) hearing on September 5, 2024 at 9:30 AM and will be heard at the OHCA Board meeting on September 17, 2024, at 2:00 PM.

## Tracheostomy Rate for Standard Nursing Facilities, Effective date: October 1, 2024, contingent upon CMS approval.

The OHCA will seek approval of a State Plan amendment and rule revisions to establish an add-on rate for regular nursing facilities serving high-acuity tracheostomy residents. For the rate period beginning October 1, 2024, the add-on rate will be \$144.79 per patient day. Reimbursement is limited to the average standard rate paid to Nursing Facilities serving adults, plus an enhancement for Acute Tracheostomy residents. The add-on rate is the difference between the total cost per day for tracheostomy care and the average standard rate paid to nursing facilities serving adults. The total cost per day for acute tracheostomy care was determined using cost data provided by nursing facilities serving acute tracheostomy residents and is the sum of four components: direct care and allied staff costs, social and support staff costs, cost of drugs and medical supplies/rentals, and general and administrative costs.

The estimated budget impact for SFY2025 will be \$1,557,225, with \$498,468 in state share; for SFY2026 the estimated budget impact will be \$2,076,299, with \$664,623 in state share.
