BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SCREENING (H0002 - \$25.32 / Event)

A formal process of evaluation of the presenting problems of an individual which results in the referral of the individual to relevant service resources. The screening process is to determine the likelihood that an individual may be experiencing mental health, substance use, trauma, or addictive disorders. The purpose is not to establish the presence or specific type of such disorder but to establish the need for referral for more in-depth clinical evaluation and assessment and/or referral to relevant service resources. Services can include the time spent on screening (face to face), time spent on assisting with intake documentation, and time spent on referral to external agencies at the time of screening and admission only. Screening is compensable on behalf of a member who is seeking services for the first time from the contracted agency and only when the provider utilizes an approved tool included in the list below.
