RE: Psychiatric Collaborative Care Model Reimbursement

Dear Provider,

As directed by Senate Bill 444 of the 2023 legislative session, Title 36 Oklahoma Statute § 6060.11a. authorizes the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to implement a Psychiatric Collaborative Care Reimbursement Model. This policy change was promulgated through the emergency rulemaking process and made effective March 27, 2024. These rules are currently viewable on the agency's policy website. If applicable, please forward this letter to your administrative, billing and compliance departments.

This model provides reimbursement for behavioral health and substance use disorder services delivered in a primary care setting. Collaborative care is a specific type of integrated care where medical providers and behavioral health providers work together to address behavioral health conditions, including mental health conditions and substance use disorders.

Policy revisions add "behavioral health integration" as a covered physician's service. (Reference OAC 317:30-5-2.) The Agency has developed <u>medical guidelines</u> that address documentation and limits to ensure proper utilization and billing.

Pursuant to state statute, the following CPT and HCPC codes are open for billing purposes:
