Dear Provider:

This letter is notification of your **responsibilities** regarding the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005. To be in compliance with the Oklahoma State Plan, this annual letter is distributed to providers who received in aggregate at least \$5 million in Medicaid payments per Tax ID number for Federal Fiscal Year 2025 (Oct. 1, 2024, to Sept. 30, 2025). The \$5 million takes into consideration payments made from the state Medicaid agency, OHCA, and/or one of the contracted managed care entities (Aetna, Humana, Oklahoma Complete Health, DentaQuest or Liberty Dental Plan).
