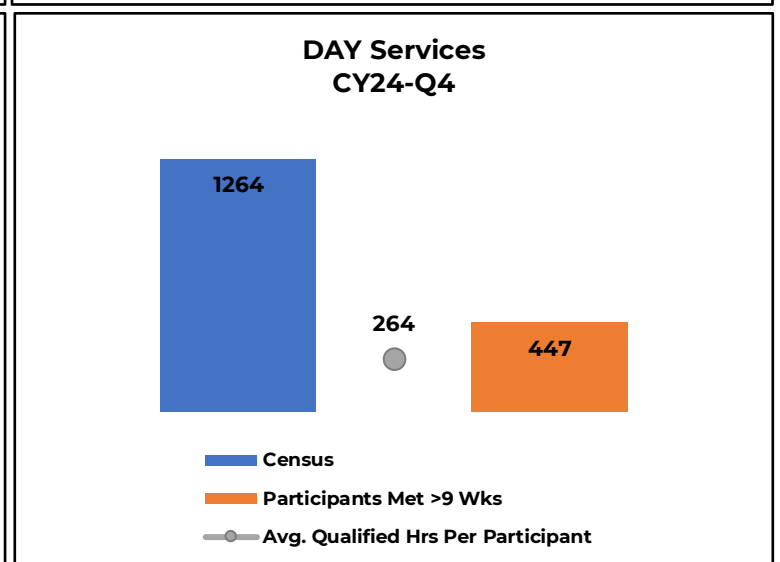
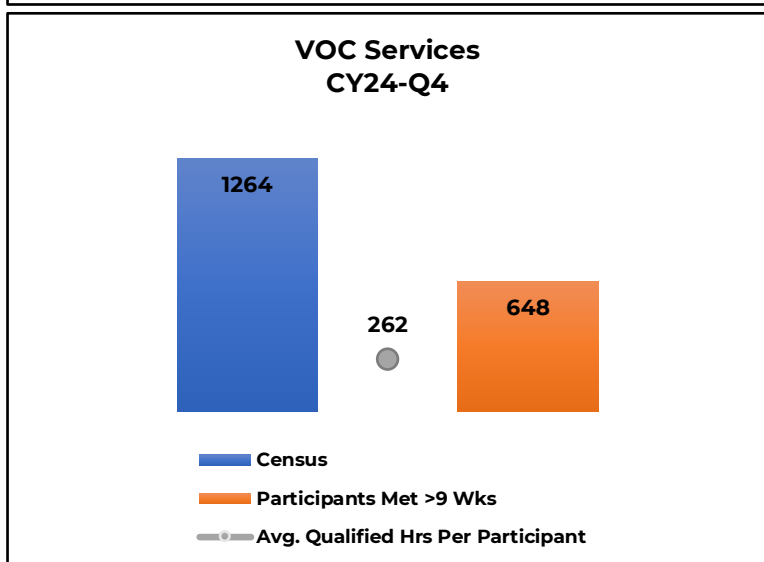
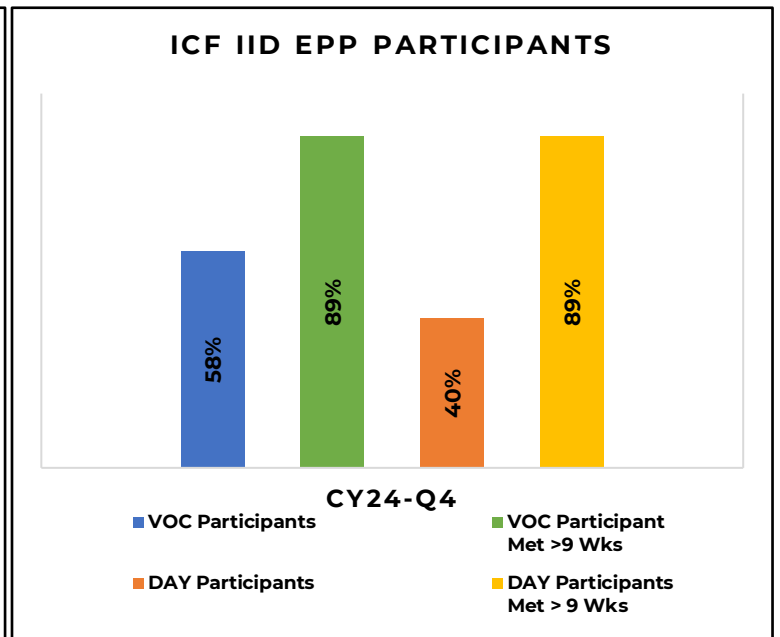
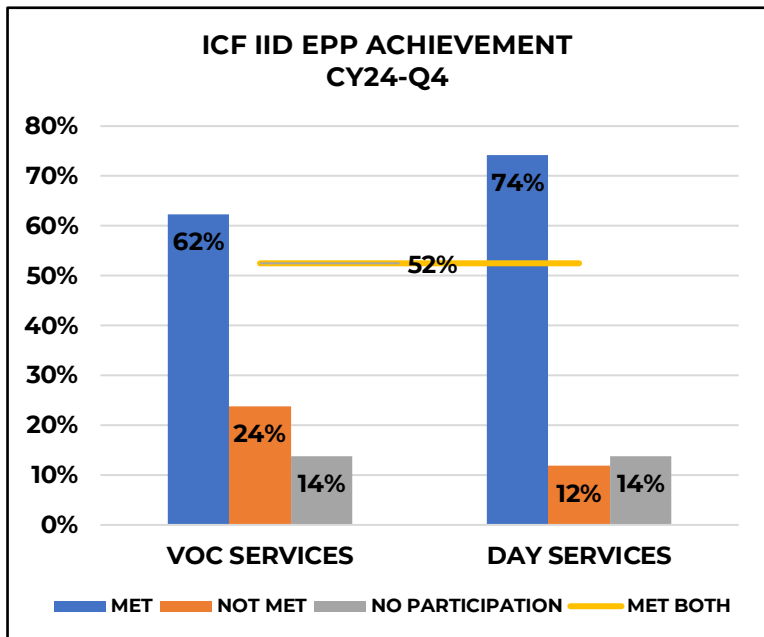
VOCATIONAL SERVICES

Provides paid employment in a structured vocational training program for residents outside of the residents' home. The type of work will vary but each provider must meet the specific program requirements. Program may assist a resident 18 years or older with other achievements to obtain gainful employment.

DAY SERVICES

Day service program provides a diverse opportunity for residents to participate in the broader community based on the resident's specific care plan. A life enrichment program is conducted in a dedicated service location. The organized programming will vary but must meet the specific program qualifications for participation.
