Adult SoonerCare Members


The prevalence of heart disease among adult SoonerCare members in SFY2022 fell to 6.1%, even while the number diagnosed only fell from 43,718 to 40,967.

This decline in prevalence is due primarily to the Medicaid expansion. which did not bring in as many adults with chronic heart disease.

In SFY2022 there were

41,564 adult members with heart disease, or 6.2% of all adult members






Prevalence Rates of Heart Disease Among Adults SFY2013 - SFY2022

Adult Members with Heart Disease by Eligibility Type SFY2022












Adult SoonerCare Members with Heart Disease




Reimbursement Cost

Reversing a decline set between SFY2019 and SFY2021, the total reimbursement for services rendered for adult members with heart disease \$788,777,455 in SFY2021 to \$849,103,149 in SFY2022.

The cost of providing care to adult members with heart disease was disproportionate to the prevalence rate of heart disease among adult SoonerCare members. Even though adult members with heart disease comprised 7.0% of all adult SoonerCare members in SFY2022, the total reimbursement for services rendered by adult members with heart disease made up 21.0% of all reimbursements paid for adult members during the state fiscal year.

SoonerCare Members with Heart Disease: Percent of Total Reimbursement Compared to Percent of Adult SoonerCare Enrollment


