
SoonerCare Members

The number of SoonerCare members diagnosed with cancer increased substantially from SFY2021 (15,059 members) to SFY2022 (19,362). Most (94.2%) were adults. The prevalence rate of cancer among SoonerCare members remained stable at 1.5%.

Among the 33 different types of cancer, defined by the *International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision*, the most common type of cancer was breast cancer, followed by secondary malignancies, other non-epithelium cancer of skin, and cancer of bronchus. Approximately one in five members with cancer (19.5%) were diagnosed with breast cancer.


Top 10 Most Frequent Cancer Diagnoses






Members with Cancer by Age Group SFY2022






Breast cancer, secondary malignancies, non-epithelial cancers of the skin and cancer of the bronchus were among the most prevalent types of cancer in SFY2022.

Cancer Prevalence Rate, Total Reimbursement, and Reimbursement per Member - Top 10 for Each Measure








Reimbursement Cost


While only 1.5% of SoonerCare members had cancer in SFY2022, the total reimbursement associated with their services made up 5.2% of all SoonerCare reimbursements paid in SFY2022. The cost of providing care to members with cancer is disproportionately higher than the prevalence of cancer among SoonerCare members. The total reimbursement for members with cancer increased by 1.0% from \$293,605,712 in SFY2020 to \$296,536,133 in SFY2021.


The average reimbursement for child members with cancer (\$30,107) was 54.8% higher than the average reimbursement for adult members with cancer (\$20,631).



SoonerCare Members with Cancer: Percent of Total Reimbursement Compared to Percent of SoonerCare Enrollment


