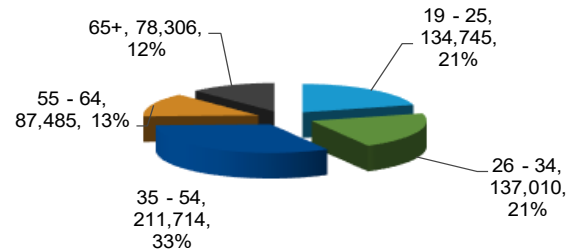

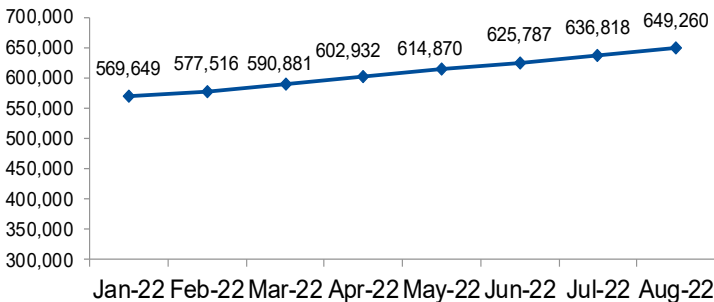

Adult Enrollment Trend

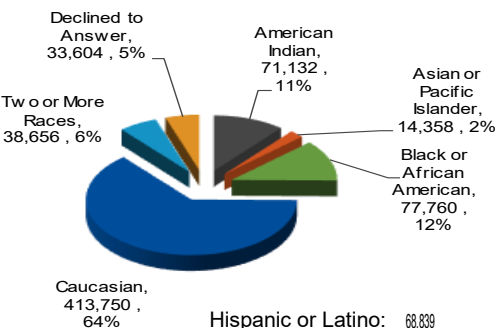
