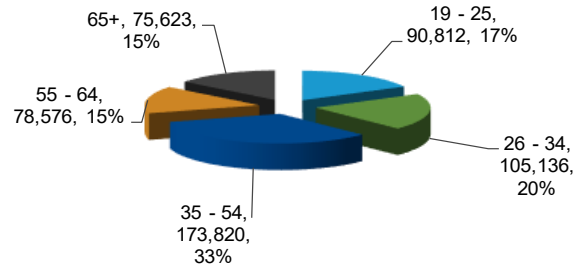

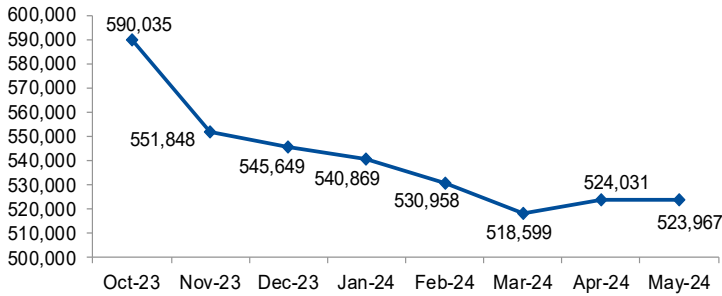

Age Breakdown of Adult Enrollment



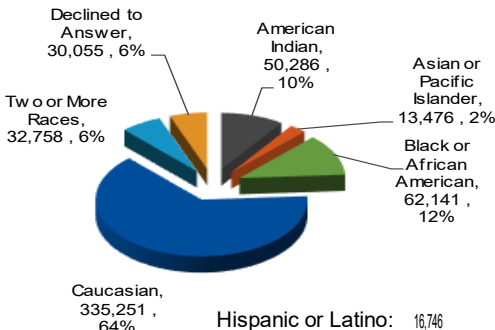
Adult Enrollment Trend
