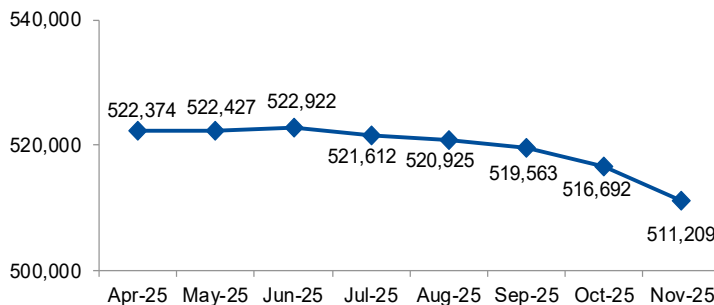

## Child Enrollment Trend



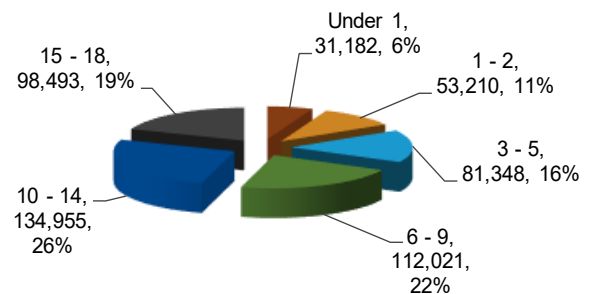

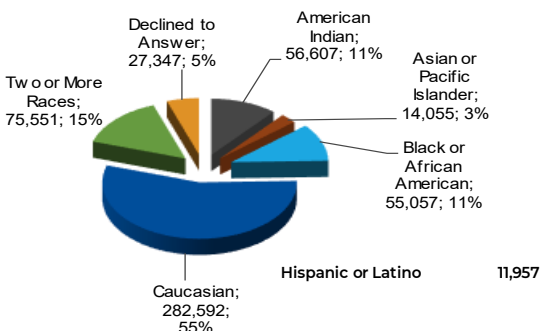
