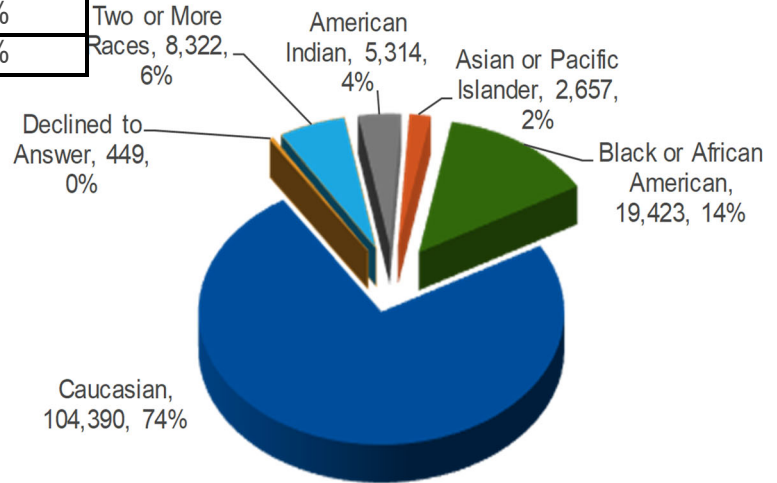

Dual Enrollees by Race



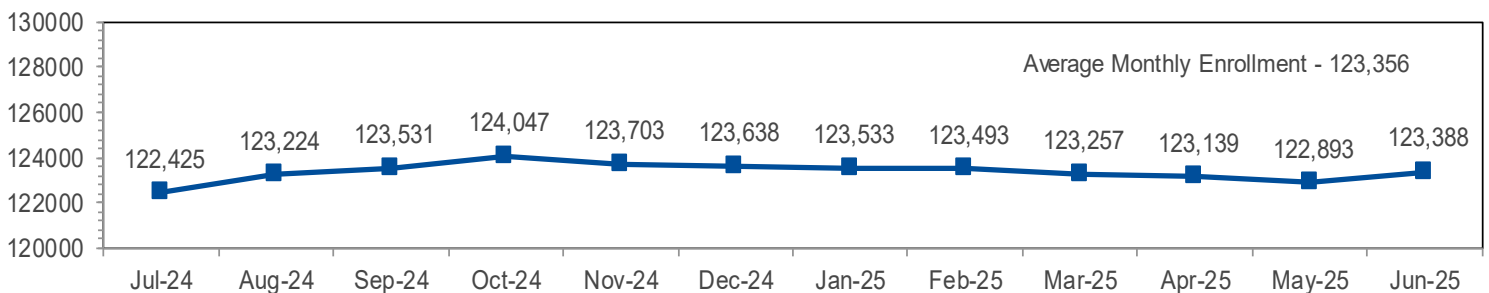

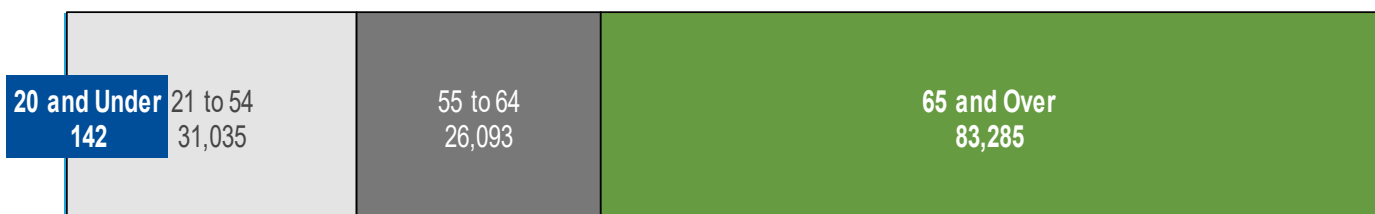
