

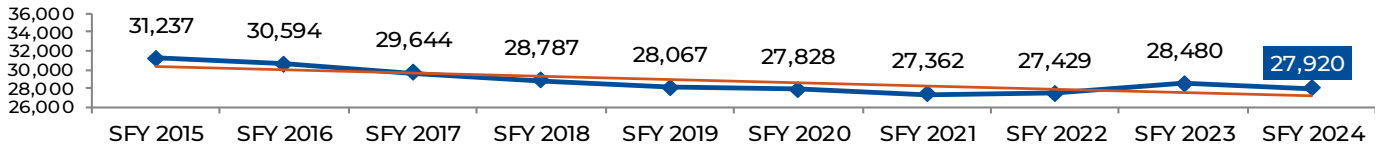
SoonerCare Delivery Fast Facts

State Fiscal Year 2024

The data below represent SoonerCare mothers with delivery dates from July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. The data are based on paid claims with delivery codes and may include non-live births, members with third-party liability, or Medicare coverage. Delivery counts represent delivery events. Mothers with multiple delivery dates are counted multiple times, while mothers with multiple infants delivered on the same date are counted once.

The number of SoonerCare-covered mothers is lower than in the previous year, partly due to changes in enrollment following the end of the Medicaid continuous enrollment requirement associated with the Public Health Emergency in 2023.

Delivery Count (Mothers)

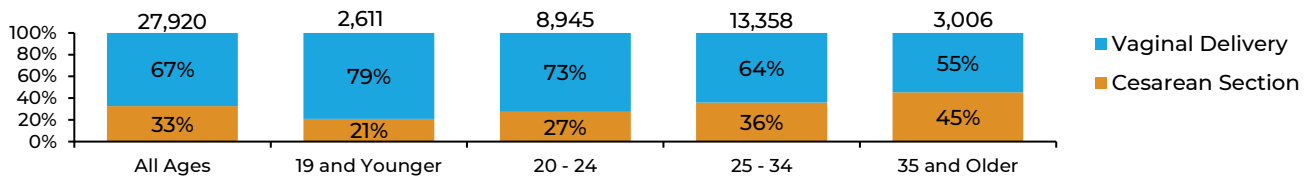

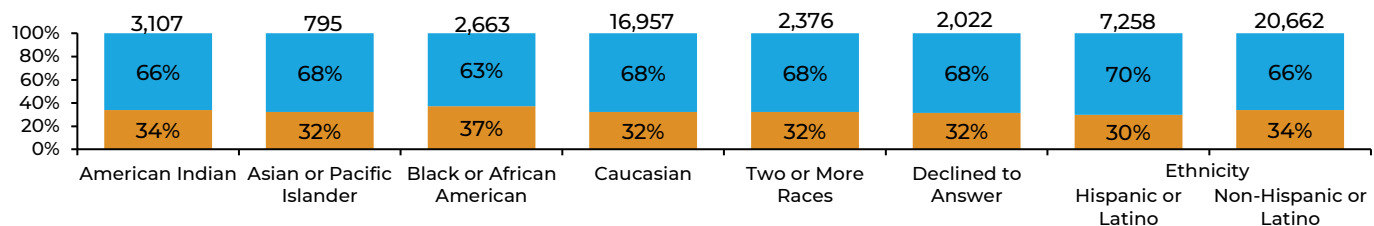

Race is self-reported by members at the time of enrollment. Members who select two or more races are grouped into the "Two or More Races" category. Hispanic or Latino is an ethnicity, not a race, and is reported separately. Age is based on the mother's age at the time of delivery.

Method of Delivery by Mother's Age

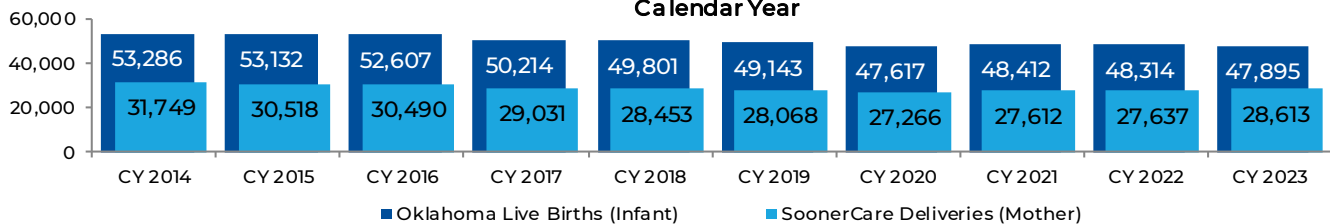


Method of Delivery by Mother's Race and Ethnicity



Method of delivery is based on hospital and professional claims and includes both live and non-live births. These data are not comparable to National Vital Statistics data, which include only live births.

Oklahoma Live Births and SoonerCare Deliveries Calendar Year

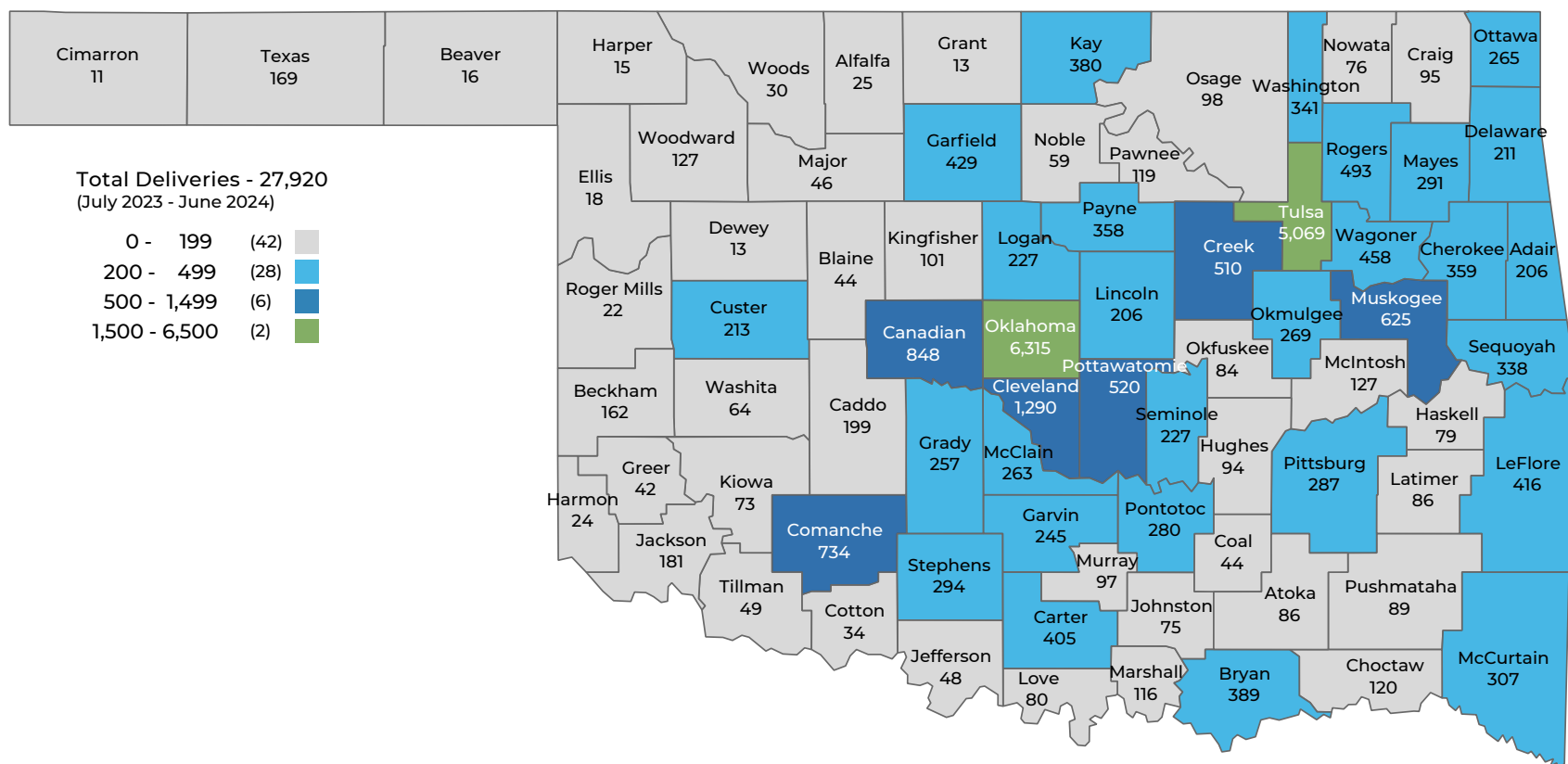


Oklahoma birth data are from birth certificate records managed by the Oklahoma State Department of Health and represent live-born infants. SoonerCare delivery data are derived from mothers' delivery claims from the Oklahoma Health Care Authority and represent delivery events among SoonerCare-enrolled mothers. SoonerCare delivery data may include non-live births.
