## RE: Rozerem® (Ramelteon) and Sklice® (Ivermectin Lotion 0.5%) Updates

Dear SoonerCare Provider,

The purpose of this fax is to provide updates regarding coverage of Rozerem® (ramelteon) and Sklice® (ivermectin lotion 0.5%).

- Rozerem® (ramelteon) is <u>brand name preferred</u> and is currently available without prior authorization. Authorization of the generic ramelteon tablets requires a patient-specific, clinically significant reason why brand formulation Rozerem® (ramelteon) tablets are not appropriate.
- Effective October 01, 2019, Sklice® (ivermectin lotion 0.5%) will move from Tier-1 to Tier-2 and require prior authorization. The authorization criteria for reimbursement is as follows:

## **Pediculicide Medications Tier-2 Approval Criteria:**

- Trials with all available Tier-1 medication(s) with inadequate response or adverse effect; and
- 2. Requested medication must be age-appropriate.
- 3. A clinical exception to Tier-1 medications applies if there is known resistance to OTC permethrin and pyrethrin.
