


HMP Clinical Measures

Coronary Artery Disease

- Antiplatelet therapy
- Drug therapy for lowering LDL cholesterol
- Beta-Blocker therapy-prior myocardial infarction (MI)
- Blood pressure <140/90
- Lipid profile performed
- Optimally managed modifiable risk
- ACE/ARB inhibitor therapy
- Symptom and activity assessment
- Lipid profile performed & LDL < 100

Diabetes

- HbA1c management
- HbA1c management control (HbA1c < 9)
- Blood pressure management
- Lipid measurement
- LDL cholesterol level <130
- LDL result <100
- Urine protein testing
- Dilated eye exam
- Foot Exam

HMP Activities

Reducing Disparities at the Practice Site

- 3 year grant initiative through the Center for Health Care Strategies (CHCS)
- o Initiative targets:
 - 10 small SoonerCare Choice practices with 1-4 providers
 - High minority population
 - High diabetic population
- Provide practice facilitation to high opportunity practices to improve quality of care provided to members with chronic conditions

SoonerCare Prenatal Tobacco Cessation Initiative

- Grant initiative from the Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust (TSET)
- o Partnership with OHCA Child Health Unit
- Provide practice facilitation to OB/GYN practices with a high volume of SoonerCare Choice members to implement quality improvement projects
 - Increase tobacco cessation activities
 - Increase use and billing of 5 A's

Product Based Prior Authorization for Atypical Antipsychotics

- Implemented on April 1, 2010
- Result of coordinated efforts of OHCA pharmacy unit and the Drug Utilization and Review Board (DUR)
- Members on tier 2 and 3 medications prior to April 1, 2010 will be grandfathered in and allowed to stay on current medications
- Extensive outreach and education provided to stakeholders:
 - o APS Healthcare
 - o Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (DMHSAS)
 - o Department of Human Services (DHS)
 - o OHCA Behavioral Health Advisory Council
 - o OHCA Inpatient Quarterly Provider Meeting (Behavioral Health providers)
 - OHCA Child Health Task Force
 - o Provider Services made calls to the top 100 prescribers of the atypical antipsychotics
 - o Fax blast to pharmacies and SoonerCare PCPs
 - o 2,000 letters sent to prescribers containing magnets to reinforce the tier one medication
 - o Article planned for the member and provider newsletter
