# Physician Consultation for Behavioral Health

lescents who are enrolled in the SoonerCare program. This latest service for SoonerCare contracted providers will begin July 1, 2008.

Historically, SoonerCare members have reported difficulty accessing psychiatric care in rural areas of Oklahoma. Studies have indicated that more than 70 percent of behavioral health consumers access those services through their Primary Care Providers (PCPs).

The Psychiatric Consultation program will facilitate <u>free</u>, informal telephonic consultations between psychiatrists and PCPs regarding psychotropic medication management for children and adolescents.

## How the Program Works

- SoonerCare PCP contacts APS Psychiatric Consultation Hotline (877.845.7468) to schedule a consultation appointment. These appointments are available at regularly scheduled times every week.
- The SoonerCare PCP should expect the consultation appointment to occur within 5 business days.
- An APS hotline specialist schedules the consultation appointment and sends a meeting invitation to both providers.
- APS psychiatrist contacts PCP at the appointed date and time to review the case and provide treatment recommendations.

# Project Goals

- Reduce frequent inpatient psychiatric hospitalizations for children and adolescents in rural areas of Oklahoma.
- Increase knowledge and confidence level of the PCP in providing psychiatric medication management.
- Reduce medication non-compliance among youthful consumers.
- ◆ Decrease inappropriate usage of psychotropic medications in consumers under 21 years of age.
- Encourage referrals to care coordination, case management, outpatient facilities or crisis services as indicated.

### The Project Does Not Include:

- Face-to-face psychiatric evaluations
- Forensic evaluations
- Opinions related to custody or competency issues
- Physician-to-physician referral process
- Full, telephonic psychiatric evaluation
