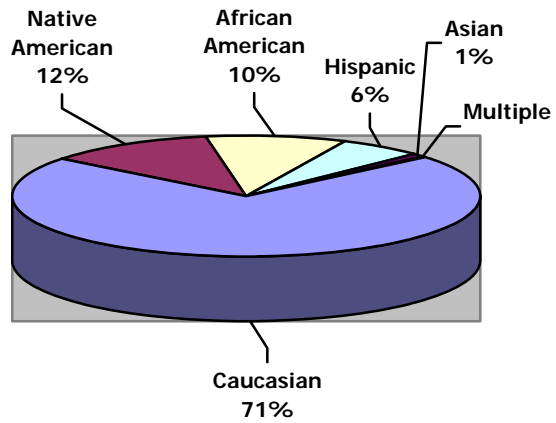

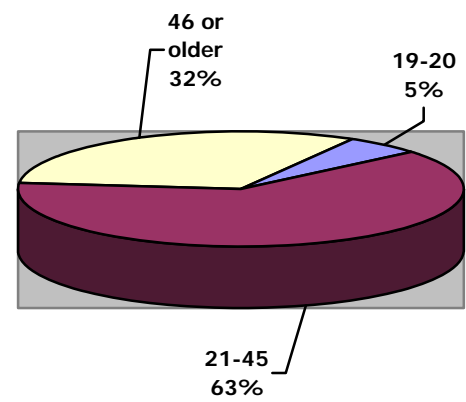

Race breakdown of women entering Oklahoma Cares program from January through December 2007.



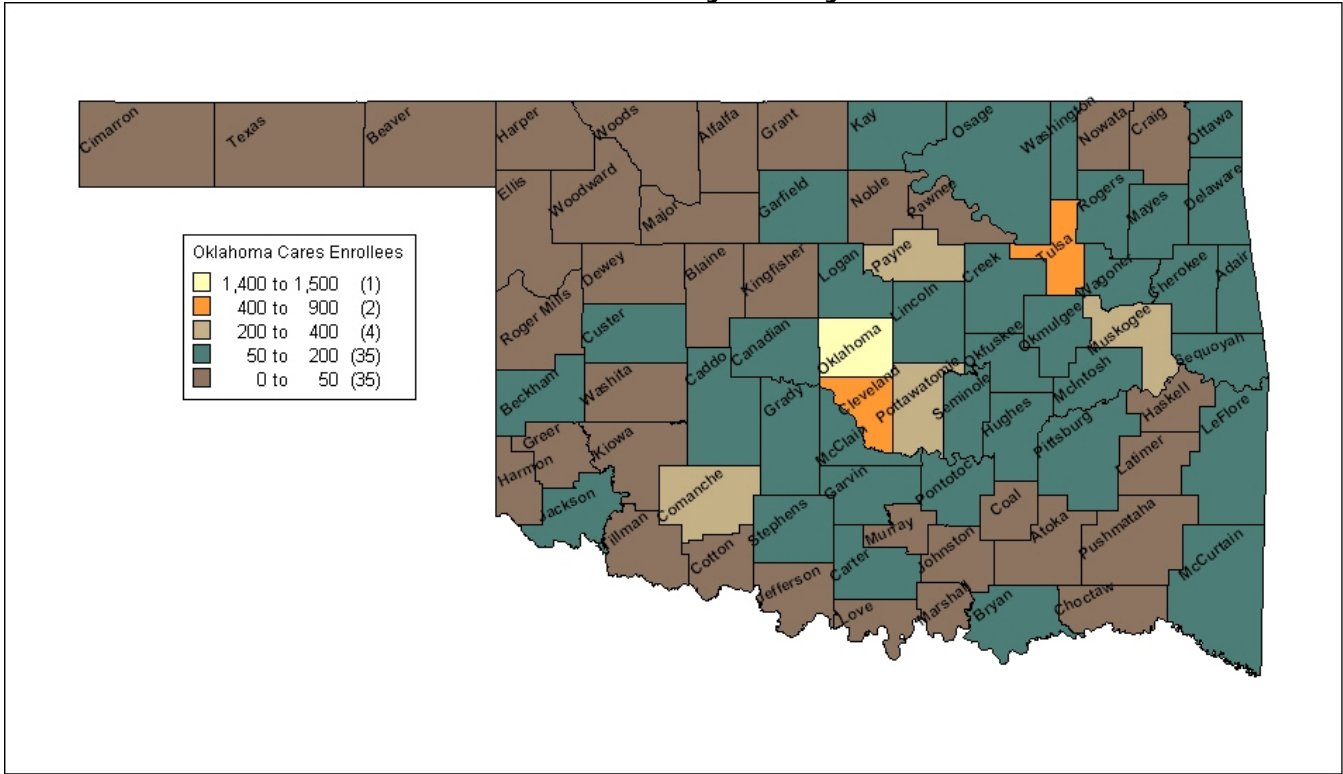
Age breakdown of women entering the Oklahoma Cares program from January through December 2007.



- Care management made 28,960 calls to assist members with diagnostic and treatment services in 2007.
- Member service coordinators made 537 call attempts to members who had a verified cancer diagnosis to provide SoonerCare orientation and alignment with primary care providers for the 2007 year.
- Additionally, member service coordinators made 1,051 call attempts to remind members that their eligibility was ending.

2007 Rule/Policy Changes

- Expansion of the mammography policy to cover additionally medically necessary mammograms following a screening mammogram and elimination of the gender restriction on this benefit.
- Coverage of external breast prostheses and garments.
- Acceptance of faxed signatures on all SoonerCare applications.
- Revision of the rules to allow an exception for the coverage of external breast prostheses in instances where a woman with breast cancer receives reconstruction following a mastectomy, but the breast implant fails or ruptures and circumstances are such that an implant replacement is not recommended by the surgeon and/or desired by the member.
- Coverage of adult therapy services in outpatient hospital-based settings effective 2008. This includes physical, occupational and speech therapy.
