## **OHCA Outstanding State Plan Amendment Update**

- Amendment adds coverage for Family Support and Training services for children experiencing a serious emotional disturbance who are in an ODMHSAS contracted systems of care community based treatment program. The total annual cost of the service is \$750,500. The original amendment was submitted 9/29/06 with an effective date of 7/1/06. When SPA 06-15 is approved, the agency will be able to withdraw this amendment as this service was included in the resubmission of SPA 06-15 on 12/2/07.
- Amendment adds coverage for Family Training and Counseling for Child Development which provides treatment services to infants and toddlers 0 3 who are identified as having specific disorders or delays in development, emotional or behavioral problems, or disorders of speech, language, vision or hearing. Additionally, EPSDT plan pages are revised to remove duplication and reorganize information. The total annual cost of the service is \$124,400. The original amendment was submitted 9/29/06 with an effective date of 7/1/06.
- Amendment revises provider educational qualifications for Behavioral Health Case Management services to comply with recommendations made by the Oklahoma Behavioral Health Collaborative. Effective 7/1/07, OHCA rules became effective to establish three levels for Certified Behavioral Health Case Managers, based on education, licensure, and experience. The amendment is budget neutral and was submitted 9/28/07 with an effective date of 7/1/07.
- Amendment adds coverage for pregnant women for genetic counseling, lactation consulting and counseling, psychosocial support by licensed clinical social workers, and prenatal coordination and patient education by licensed practitioners. The total annual cost of the service is \$1,918,838. The amendment was submitted 12/31/07 with an effective date of 11/1/07.
- O7-19 Amendment revises reimbursement for hospital based children's dental clinics and psychiatric residential treatment facilities. The total annual cost of the amendment is \$254,793. The amendment was submitted 12/31/07 with an effective date of 1/1/08.
- O8-01 Amendment revises the monthly maximum income standards for the state supplementary payments made by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services. The revision is necessary due to the annual increase of the SSI payment standard. The amendment is budget neutral and was submitted 1/10/08 with an effective date of 1/1/08.
- O8-02 Amendment revises the reimbursement methodology for Community Mental Health Centers. The total annual cost of the amendment is \$2,863,222. The amendment was submitted 2/13/08 with an effective date of 7/1/08.
