## EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT EXECUTIVE ORDER 2018-18

I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Oklahoma Statutes in 25 O.S. Section 82.1, hereby order the following dates be observed as holidays by the State of Oklahoma in 2019:

| Monday              | February 18, 2019      | Presidents' Day             |
| Monday              | May 27, 2019           | Memorial Day                |
| Thursday            | July 4, 2019           | Independence Day            |
| Monday              | September 2, 2019      | Labor Day                   |
| Monday              | November 11, 2019      | Veterans Day                |
| Thursday & Friday   | November 28 & 29, 2019 | Thanksgiving                |
| Tuesday & Wednesday | December 24 & 25, 2019 | Christmas                   |

This Executive Order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services who shall cause the provisions of this Order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
