"Public Service Recognition Week"

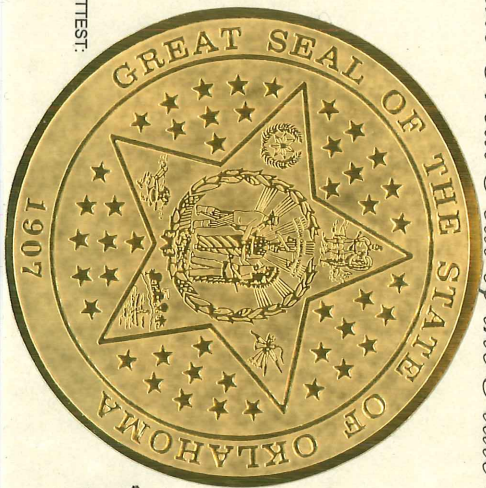
in the State of Oklahoma.
