1. Contract Term and Renewal Options

The initial Contract term, which begins on the effective date of the Contract, is one year and there are six (6) one-year options to renew the Contract.

2. Specifications

Mandatory Requirements are detailed below and incorporated herein.

3. Mandatory Requirements

- 3.1 Supplier must have long perpetual storage & retrieval of imaging data.
- 3.2 Supplier shall provide a hosted solution on Virtual Machine (VM). The Application, the database and the Images are all stored on Servers.
- 3.3 Supplier must integrate with OMES VM server.
- 3.4 Supplier shall make system requirements as needed on the (VM). The database is the PACS, and organizes and retrieves DICOM images (X-rays/CTS) and shall include the following.

 - 3.4.2 EXa Full DICOM viewer
