A. Call to Order, Roll Call, and Determination of Quorum:

C. Land Use and Development Applications:



1. <u>Discussion and possible action regarding BP-23-24-23</u>, request by Jason Shaffer, JMS <u>Builds LLC</u>, on behalf of Oklahoma Education Association for a building permit for conversion of two open patios into enclosed spaces on the second story of the existing building at 323 E. Madison Street in Oklahoma City.

Mr. Jones presented background information on the property at 323 E. Madison Street in Oklahoma City for full enclosure of the two existing patios on the second story of the Oklahoma Education Association (OEA) Building.

Staff recommended approval of the building permit for the conversion of two open patios on the second story of the building into enclosed spaces, with the finding that the proposed work is consistent with the commission's master land use plan and complies with the applicable zoning rules subject to the conditions that: 1) The applicant must obtain a building permit from the City of Oklahoma City prior to the commencement of work; 2) All work must comply with the applicable City of Oklahoma City building code.

Brian Downs moved to approve BP-23-24-23. Anderson Dark seconded the motion. The following votes were recorded, and the motion passed:
