a. This is to incorporate the following:

C1. Good morning, It has been brought to my attention the cover page has the solicitation number as 0300000293; however, it should read 0900000293. This is the solicitation number that should be used when marking the envelopes and referencing this bid request.

Q1. Is VPAT required by bidders supplying Access Control, Video Surveillance, and Intrusion Detection solutions? As a system integrator we supply and support several different systems required for Access Control, Video Surveillance, and Intrusion Detection solutions. For Access Control, Video Surveillance, and Intrusion Detection solutions, will VPAT be required from the manufacturer for each platform proposal in our cost/price package?

A1. Yes, a VPAT is required by all bidders.

Q2. Please define alert as it relates to section C.7.?

A2. Alerts relate to issues that arise regarding system performance.

Q3. As a system integrator we supply several Access Control Video Surveillance, and Intrusions Detection solutions that integrate into multiple other systems. Additionally we will be providing several platforms as part of the cost/pricing package, will a statement of integration be required for each platform?

A3. Yes as requested in Section C.12.

Q4. Will the bidder be allowed to submit the complete bid package in a single manila envelope with the technical, price/cost proposals in separate envelopes within the larger envelope, or are we required to send multiple sealed envelopes?

A4. One envelope containing a separate sealed envelope is acceptable. Please make sure one USB is marked as

Q5. There is a fee to accept and process a P-Card, will we be allowed to recover that cost as a condition of accepting P-Card payment?

A5. A P-Card processing fee must be outlined in the cost submission and would affect the bidders overall pricing score.

Q7. E.13.4. This section indicates that a VPAT Instruction Template is included in this RFP, where can this be found?
