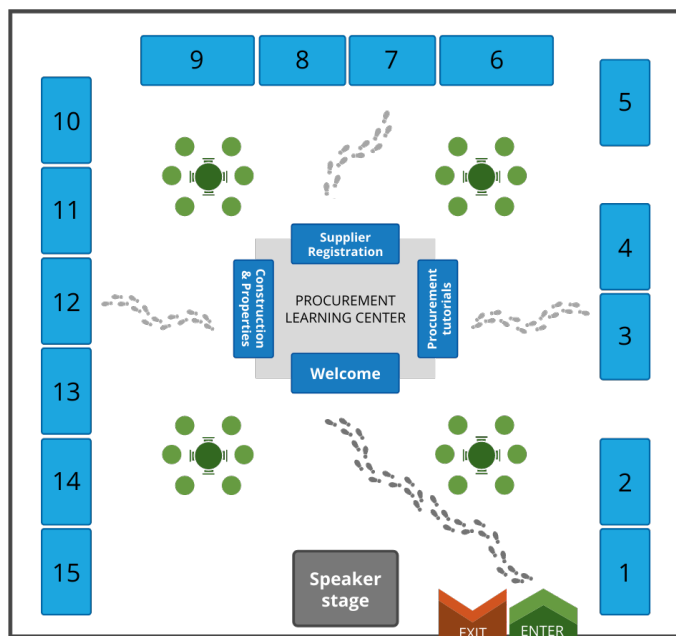
**When:** Tuesday, Oct. 19, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
