Re: Workday Semi-Annual Update released this weekend

To all interested parties:

Workday's semi-annual feature update, 2023R1, will be released this weekend to our production environment during regularly scheduled weekly maintenance. Agencies do not need to take any actions.

The Workday@OK Support Team has been testing the release functionality for the last 5 weeks to ensure our core functions, integrations and reports work alongside the new features.

Each release contains features that are automatically available and features that require configuration or setup. As this is our first release with the new system, only the automatically available updates will be available, and all other updates will be added to our enhancement log.

You can expect to see changes to fields and functionality across the system. This is a summary of the changes, <u>Workday 2023 Release 1: Analytics and</u> **Reporting**.

Please note, not all documented changes will apply to the state of Oklahoma's current configuration.
