

MINUTES OF A MEETING
OF THE
OKLAHOMA NEW MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

In conformity with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, advance notice of this Regular meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on November 17, 2025. Public notice of this meeting, together with the agenda, was posted in prominent public view on the front door of the Northwest Office Center, 4334 NW Expressway, Oklahoma City, on March 9th, 2026 prior to 10am, and, announcement of the Board meeting and agenda were posted on the ONMVC website www.oklahoma.gov/onmvc on March 9th, 2026, 2026 prior to 10am.

The Oklahoma New Motor Vehicle Commission met in a Regular Meeting at 10:00 am, March 10th, 2026. Chair Curtis Hayes called the meeting to order. A roll call was held; members present were Jackie McClintock, Sam Wampler, Cassie McGlothlin, Jeff Johnson, Jim Norton, Jared Glover and Curtis Hayes. Commissioners Seth Wadley and Jack Hodge were absent.

The Chair announced that there were enough members present to constitute a quorum. Also present were Brad Bailey, Executive Director, Marilyn Maxwell, Deputy Executive Director, Scott May, Assistant Attorney General, Ty Mowdy, Assistant Attorney General, and Peter Hodges of the Oklahoma Automobile Dealers Association.

Each Commission Member received a copy of the **Minutes** from the February 11th, 2026 meeting. Director's Report

The Executive Director informed the Commissioners that there had been six new complaints since the last meeting, with four complaints being resolved and two complaints closed. There had been two carryover complaints since the last meeting.

The Director presented a report on legislation of interest to the ONMVC, the industry including the bills that failed to advance from their original chamber and the remaining bills that were advancing to the opposite chamber of the Legislature.

The Director provided an update on progress of development of a Statement of Work for the ONMVC's eLicensing system, expectation for a quote from the vendor of choice, Mi-Case PA, LLC, and progress in obtaining contracting approval from OMES Central Purchasing

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The Director provided an update on the Commission's Request for Information for an Ai-based online dealer advertising evaluation tool.

Under update of other agency activities, the Deputy Executive Director provided an update on the hiring of an assistant and the Chair provided an update on the candidate search for a new Executive Director due to the pending departure of Director Bailey.

As part of the discussion the Executive Director, staff, and Commissioners discussed a variety of advertising rule enforcement topics, including the progress and nature of mystery shops and how they should be examined and how complaints should proceed in terms of enforcement.
