



The following documents may be reviewed as proof of citizenship:

US CITIZEN OR US NATIONAL STATUS

- Birth certificate showing birth in one of the 50 states within the U.S. or its outlying possessions
- Non-expired United States passport (except limited passports and passport ID "cards")
- Report of birth abroad of a U.S. citizen (FS-240)
- Certificate of birth (FS-545)
- Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570)
- Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561)
- US Citizenship ID Card (I-197)
- American Indian Card - classification code "KIC"

ALIEN LAWFULLY ADMITTED FOR PERMANENT RESIDENCE

- INS Form I-551
- Unexpired Temporary I-551

IMMIGRANT OR NON-IMMIGRANT VISA STATUS

- INS Form I-766 annotated A3, A5 or A10
- INS Form I-94 annotated § 203 (a)(7), § 207, § 208, or § 212(d)(5)
- INS Form I-688B annotated 27a.12(a)(5), 274a.12(a)(3), or 274a.12(a)(10)

OTHER DOCUMENTS

An individual with DACA status does **not** meet our licensing requirements as a lawfully admitted alien.
