Commission Regulatory Services for Combat Events & Promotions

- **Event Permits & Approvals** – reviewing and approving all event permit applications.
- **Venue & Safety Inspections** – ensuring compliance with safety standards (ring, cage, medical equipment, ambulance on site).
- **Bout Approvals** – reviewing matchups for fairness, records, medical status, and suspensions.
- **Promoter Regulation** – enforcing disclosure requirements, financial responsibility, and compliance with federal (Ali Act) and state law.
- **Officials Assignment** – appointing licensed referees, judges, inspectors, timekeepers, and commission reps.
- **Insurance Verification** – confirming health/accident insurance coverage for participants, and general liability.

Commission Services for Fighters

- **Licensing** – issuing licenses to fighters, trainers, managers, promoters, matchmakers, and officials.
- **Medical Requirements** – verifying bloodwork and over 40 applicants physicals, eye exams, MRIs, stress tests. Pre-fight physical and pregnancy tests to ensure fighters can fight.
- **Weight Monitoring** – conducting official weigh-ins and enforcing weight classes.
- **Health & Safety Oversight** – two ringside physician's to ensure safe fights, administer stitches, injury protocols for EMSA, and suspend fighters based on knockouts/medical reasons and injury.
- **National Registry Reporting** – entering results and suspensions into Federal and Nation databased to ensure compliance MMA registry & Boxrec.

- **Fighter ID Cards** – issuing and maintaining identification cards (per Ali Act requirements).

Commission Services During the Event

- **Event Supervision** – inspectors present to inspect all fighter and managers bags and equipment, monitor locker rooms, hand wrapping, corner conduct, and adherence to rules.
- **Rule Enforcement** – applying the Unified Rules for boxing, MMA, kickboxing, Muay Thai, bare-knuckle, and other disciplines.
- **Instant Replay (if available)** – reviewing potential fight-ending fouls or errors.
- **Scoring & Decision Oversight** – ensuring judges’ scorecards are accurate, collected, and tallied correctly.
- **Emergency Medical Response** – physician and EMT coordination for injuries.
- **Discipline** – issuing suspensions, fines, or disqualifications for fouls, misconduct, or unsportsmanlike behavior.

Commission Services After the Event

- **Results Certification** – confirming bout outcomes and filing official results.
- **Suspension Reporting** – entering medical and disciplinary suspensions into the national database.
- **Contract & Purse Review** – ensuring fighter compensation matches disclosed contracts, no coercive contracts (Ali Act).
- **Dispute Handling** – managing protests and appeals.
