Selected Findings: Hate Crime, 2022

April 15, 2026

Definition: A criminal offense committed against a person or property, which is motivated by the offender’s bias against race, religion, ethnic/national origin, sexual orientation, or disability.

Per [Title 21 O.S. § 850](#), the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation is required to collect Hate/Bias crime data. In 2022, law enforcement agencies reported 64 unique Hate/Bias Crime incidents. As displayed in Table 1, the most common types of Hate/Bias reported were Race/Ethnicity/Ancestry (65.6%) and Sexual Orientation (20.3%). Specifically, the highest reported Hate/Bias for Race/Ethnicity/Ancestry was Anti-Black, with 29 incidents. For incidents with a Hate/Bias related to Sexual Orientation, the highest reported was Anti-Homosexual (Gay & Lesbian), with 6 incidents.

In 2022, the highest number of Hate/Bias incidents occurred in April (Figure 1), and over 50.0% of incidents occurred between April and July. In addition, the lowest number of incidents occurred in December. Nearly two-thirds of Hate/Bias incidents occurred from Monday to Wednesday, with the highest number occurring on a Tuesday (Figure 1). As displayed in Figure 2, the highest number of incidents reportedly occurred between 1000 - 1059, 1700 - 1759, and 2100 - 2159. After these increases, the number of incidents per hour decreased.

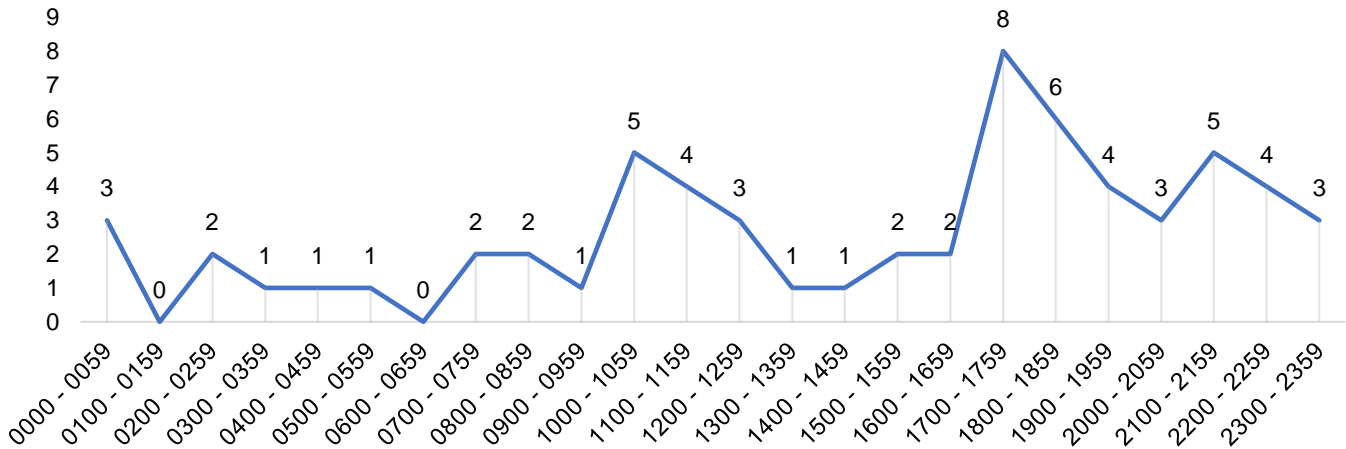

In 2022, there were 101 victims reported in the Hate/Bias incidents. Of those 101 victims, there were 81 Individuals, 9 Businesses, 8 Society/Public, 2 Government, and 1 Religious Organization (Table 2). Of the individuals, 40 were Female, 39 were Male, and for 2, the sex was Unknown. More than 40.0% of victims were either Under 18 years old or between 30 - 39 years old. The majority (87.7%) of victims were either White or Black, and over 50.0% of victims were reportedly Non-Hispanic (Table 3).

There were 73 offenders reported in the 64 Hate/Bias incidents. Of those 73 offenders, 54 were Male, 7 were Female, and for 12, the sex was Unknown (Table 3). The most common races reported for offenders were White and Unknown. The majority of offenders' ethnicity was either Unknown (49.3%) or Non-Hispanic (47.9%). Over 60.0% of offenders were either Under 18, between 20 - 39 years old, or the age was Unknown.
