## Selected Findings: Property Loss and Recovered, 2023

The State Incident-Based Reporting System (SIBRS) collects data for the loss of property when one of the follow crimes occurs: Crime Against Property, Kidnapping/Abduction, Drug/Narcotic Violations, Drug Equipment Violations, or Gambling Offenses. The type of data includes: loss type (e.g., Burned, Recovered, Stolen/Etc., Seized), type of property, and the value of the property.

In 2023, there were 272,724 unique property items reported lost/recovered, totaling \$554,034,351 (Table 1). The majority of items and values were reported as Stolen/Etc.; followed by Seized, Recovered, and Destroyed/Damaged/Vandalized. Compared to 2021, the number of property items and values reported decreased by 10.5% and 15.1%, respectively, by 2023 (Figure 1). The number of property items decreased by 6.9% in 2022 and 3.8% in 2023, while the value of property reported decreased by 6.8% in 2022 and 8.8% in 2023.

Table 2 displays the number of property items and values stolen and recovered by property type. In 2023, Currency/ID/Info and Merchandise/Goods were the most common items stolen; in contrast, Merchandise/Goods and Vehicles & Accessories were the most common items recovered. Compared to items stolen, Vehicles & Accessories and Currency/ID/Info had the highest value stolen. Of the recovered values,

Vehicles & Accessories and Industrial/Heavy Equipment had the highest values recovered.

Lastly, when analyzing the recovery rate for property types by items and value, Vehicles & Accessories and Merchandise/Goods had the highest recovery rates by item, 37.2% and 23.3% respectively (Table 2). Similarly, Vehicles & Accessories had the highest recovery rate by value, followed by Industrial/Heavy Equipment. In contrast, Merchandise/Goods had the second highest recovery rate by item (23.3%), but had a significantly lower recovery rate by value (5.6%). Overall, in 2023, 14.6% of Stolen Property Items and 28.7% of Stolen Property Value were recovered.

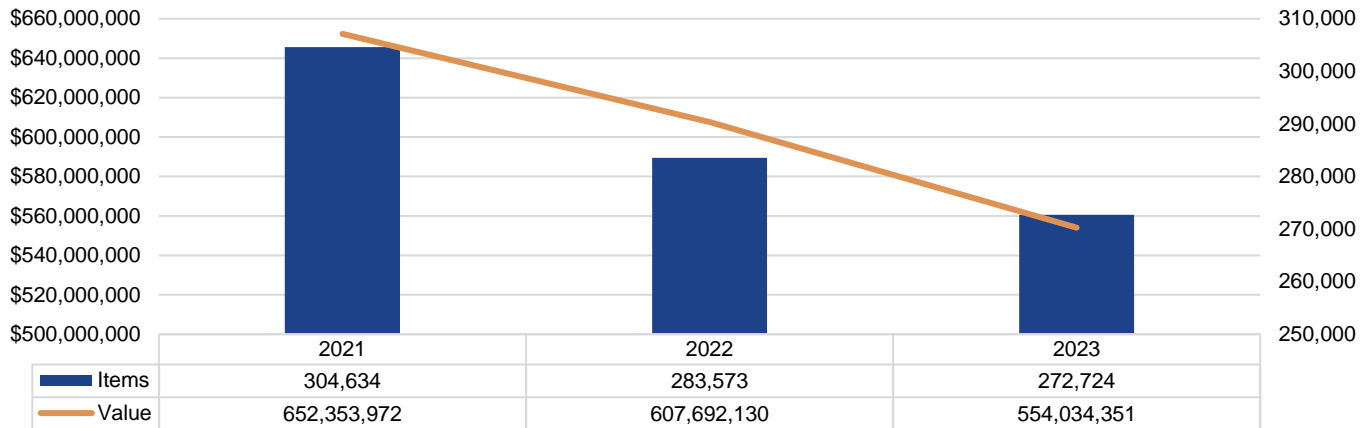
