Selected Findings: Property Loss and Recovered, 2024

The State Incident-Based Reporting System (SIBRS) collects data for the loss of property when one of the following crimes occurs: Crime Against Property, Kidnapping/Abduction, Drug/Narcotic Violations, Drug Equipment Violations, or Gambling Offenses. The type of data collected includes: loss type (e.g., Burned, Recovered, Stolen/Etc., Seized), type of property, and the value of property.

In 2024, there were 259,402 unique property items reported as a loss, totaling \$519,818,072. The most-reported type of loss was Stolen/Etc., which represented 64.5% of property items, followed by Seized (16.3%), Recovered (9.8%), and Destroyed/Damaged/Vandalized (8.3%). In terms of the property value, the biggest property loss reported was Stolen/Etc. (66.3%), followed by Recovered (16.8%) and Destroyed/Damaged/Vandalized (9.6%).

Figure 1 shows the number of property items and values associated with property loss. The number of property items decreased by 4.9% in 2024, continuing the 3.8% decrease in 2023. Similarly, the value of property loss reported decreased by 6.2%, continuing the decreases from 2023 (8.8%). When comparing 2024 to 2022, the number of property items lost decreased by 8.5% and the value decreased by 14.5%.

Table 2 displays the recovery rates of stolen property in terms of the number of items and the value by the type of property. The highest rates of property items recovered include Vehicles & Accessories (35.8%), Merchandise/Goods (25.1%), and Structures (14.6%). In comparison, the highest rates of property recovered by value were Vehicles & Accessories (53.5%), Industrial/Heavy Equipment (23.1%), and Weapons & Accessories (12.5%).

Figure 1. Property Items and Value Lost, 2022 - 2024

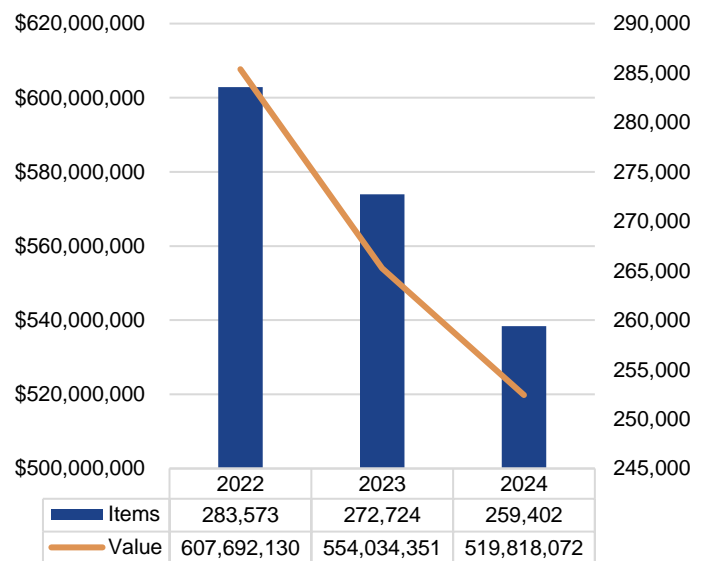
