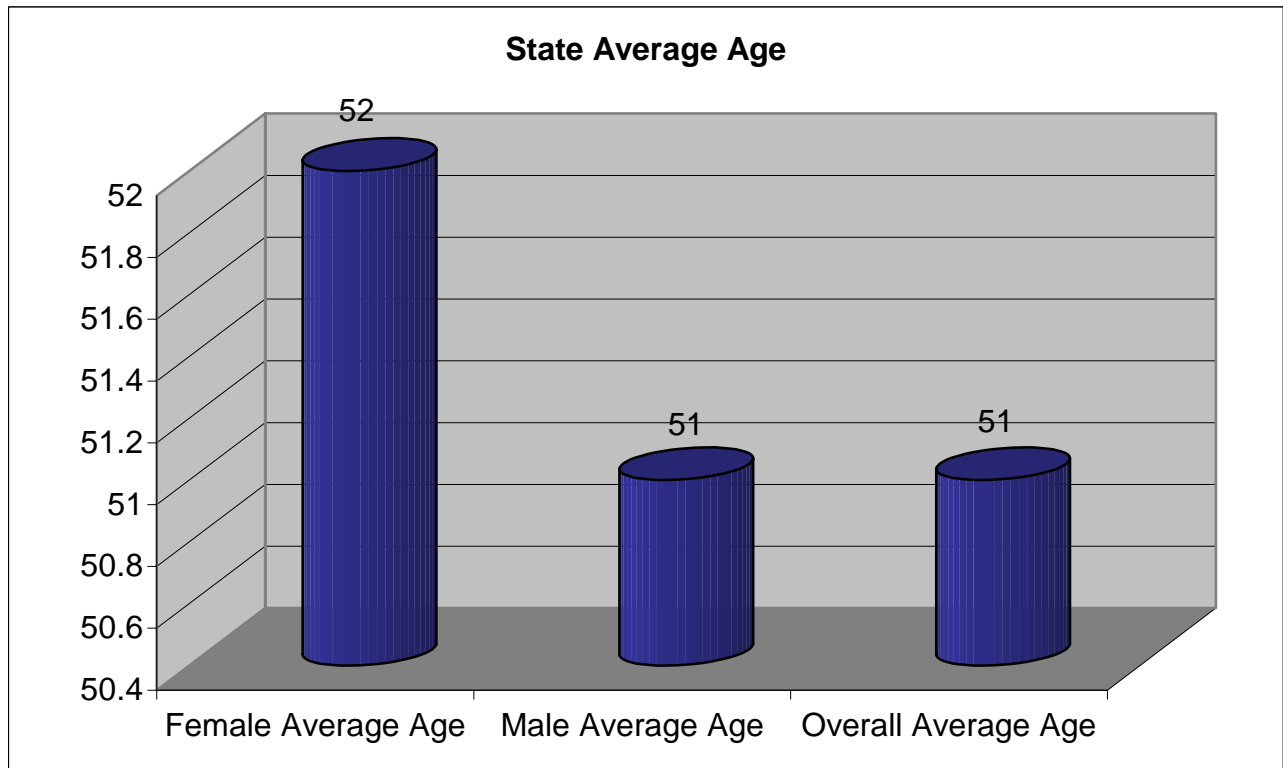

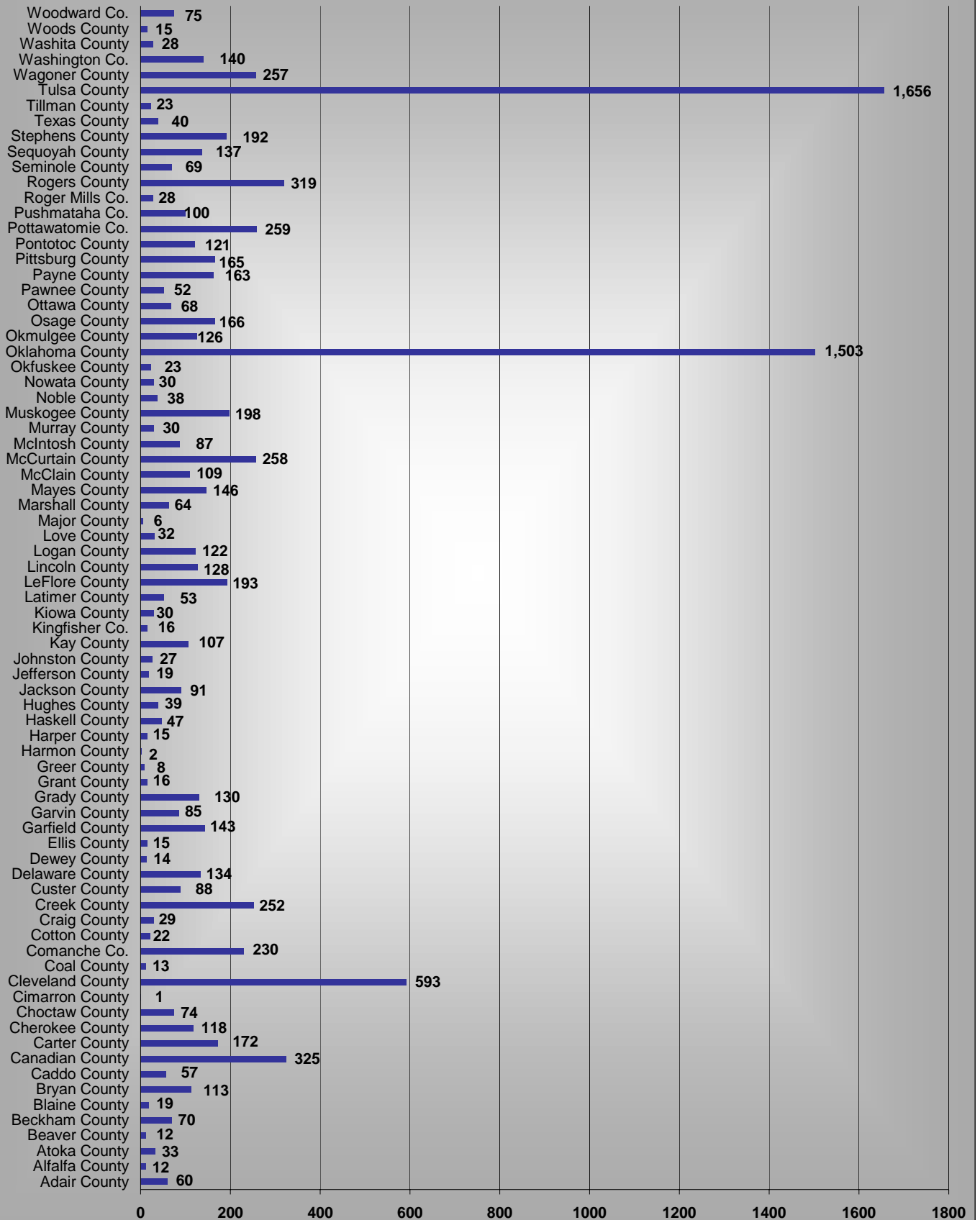

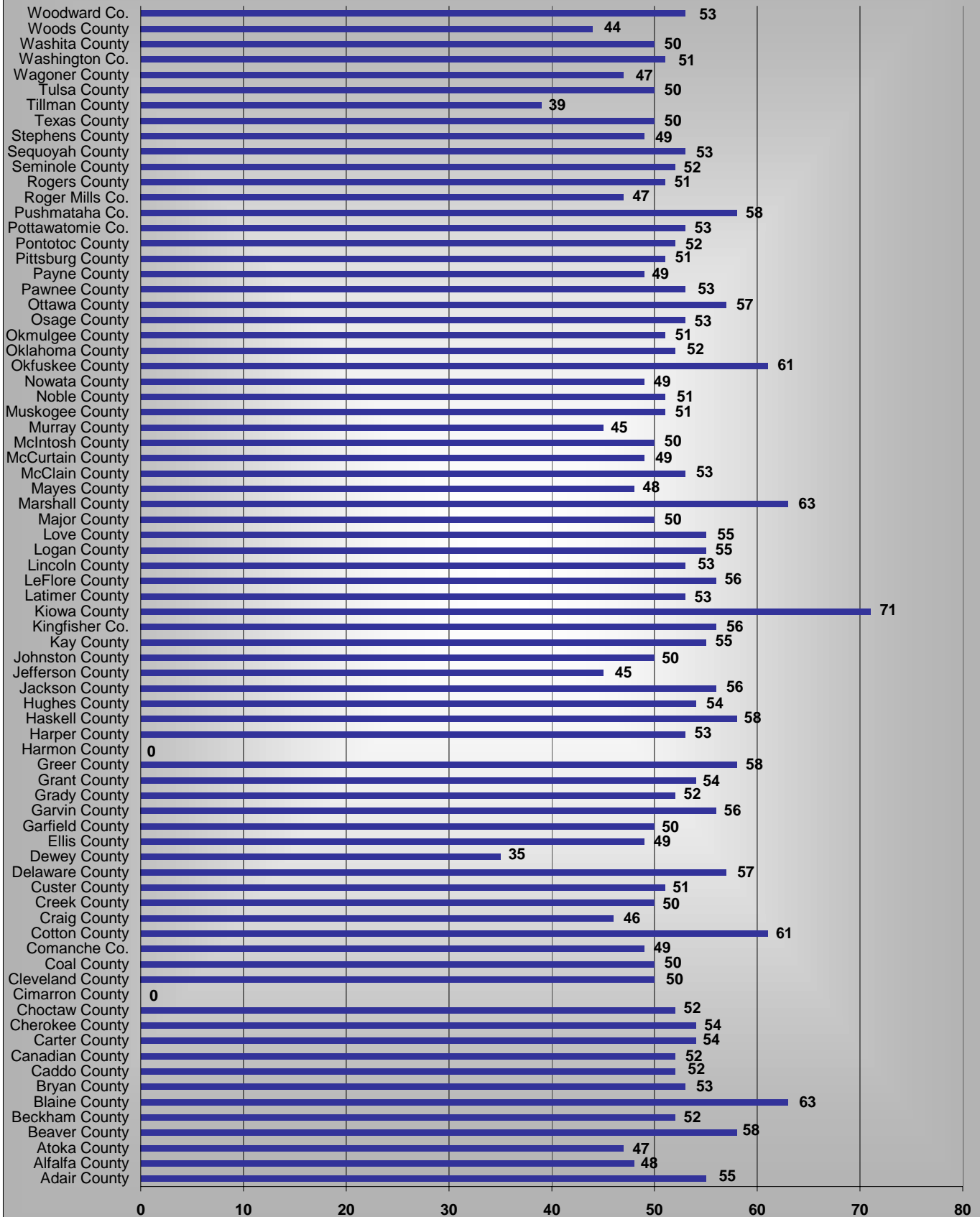

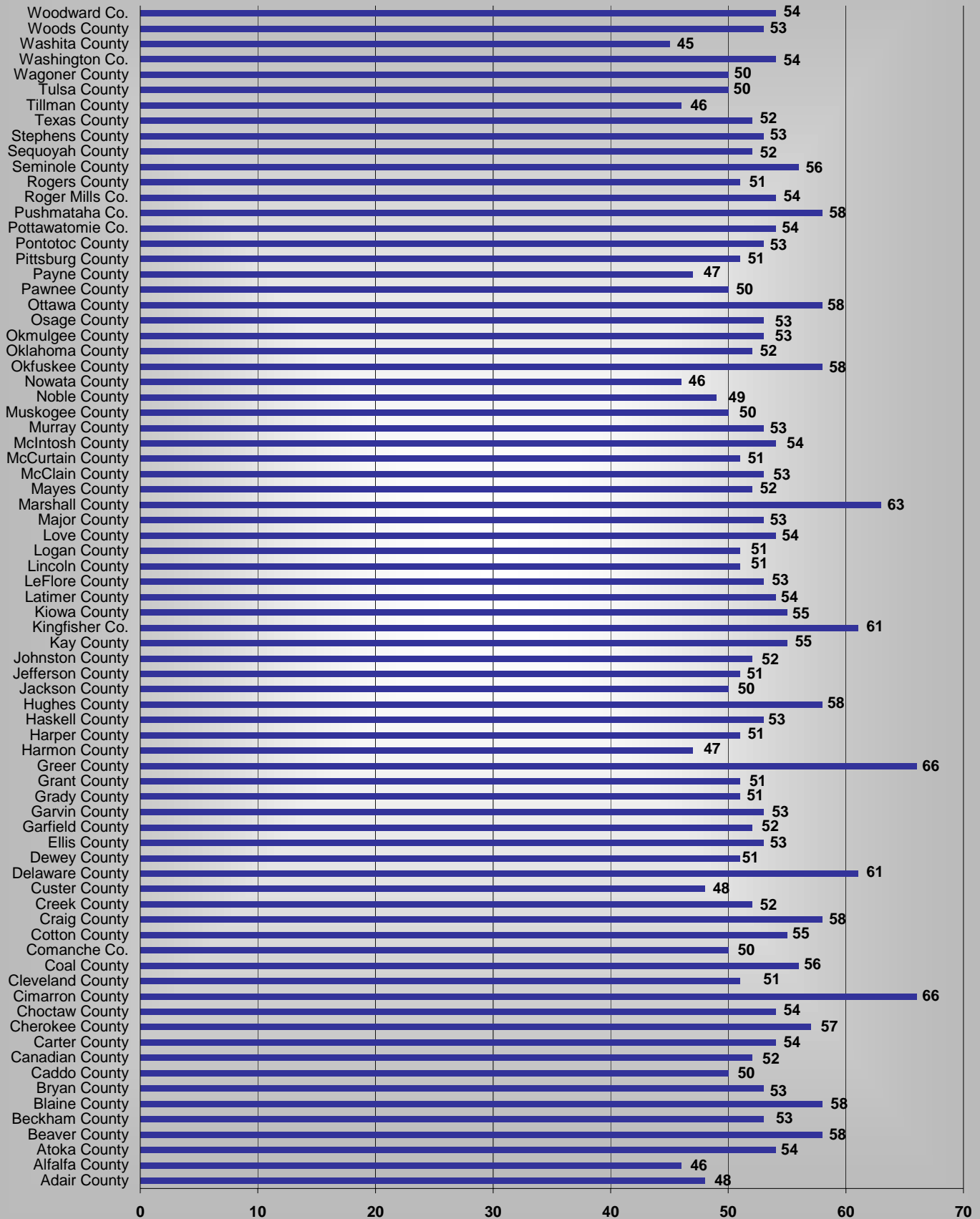
### APPROVED BY COUNTY - TOTAL NUMBER



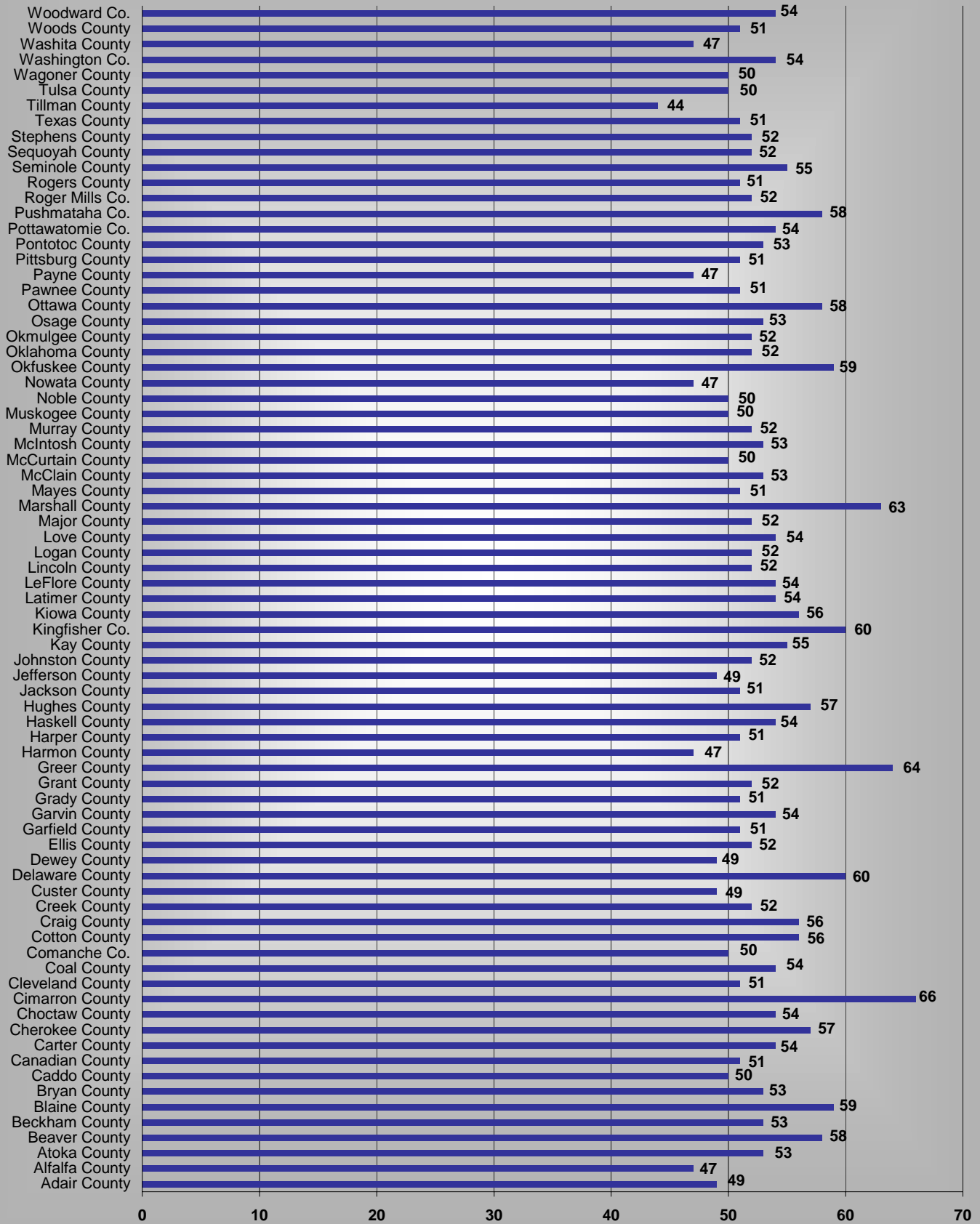
### AVERAGE FEMALE AGE APPROVED BY COUNTY

OVERALL AVERAGE AGE APPROVED BY COUNTY



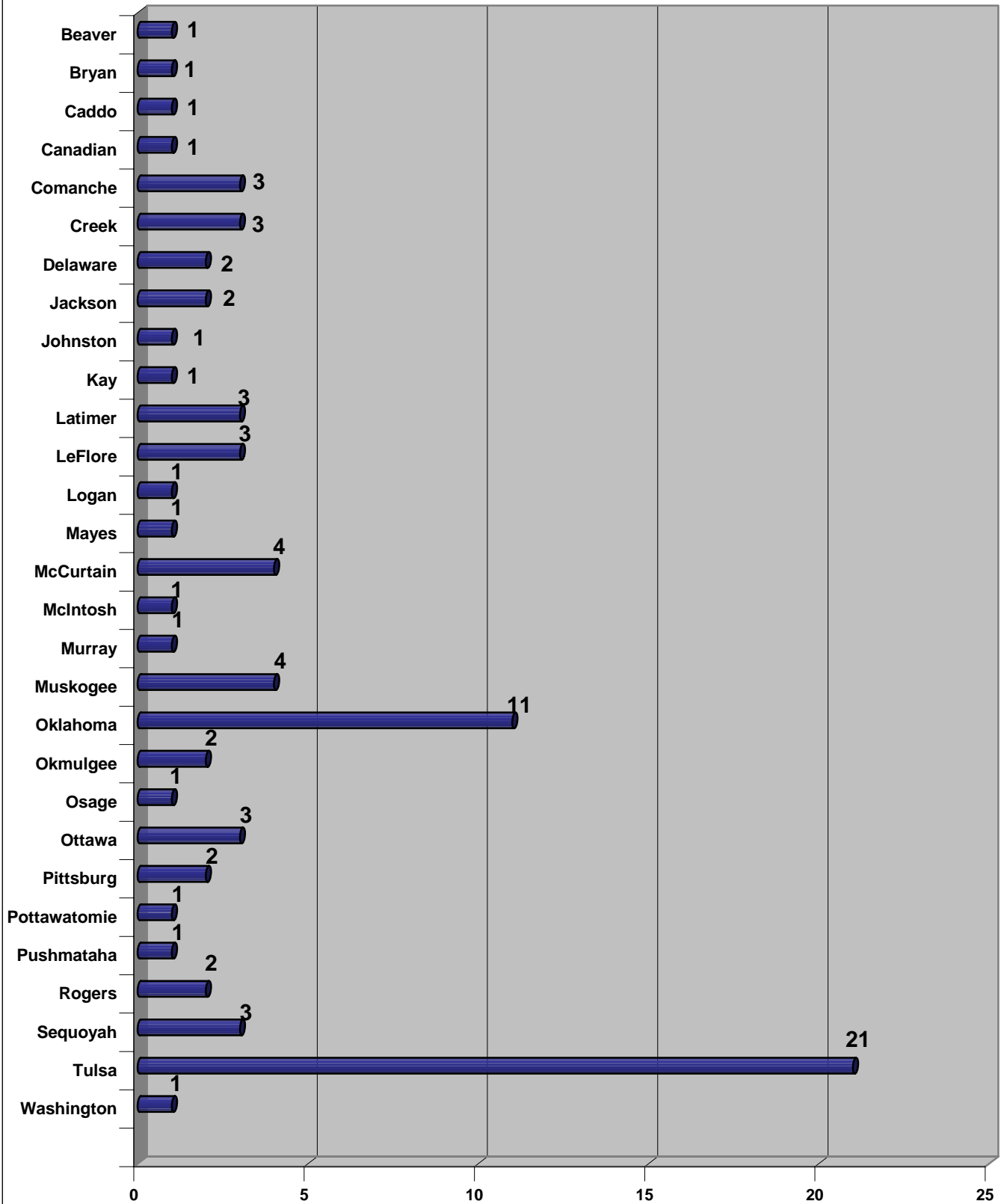

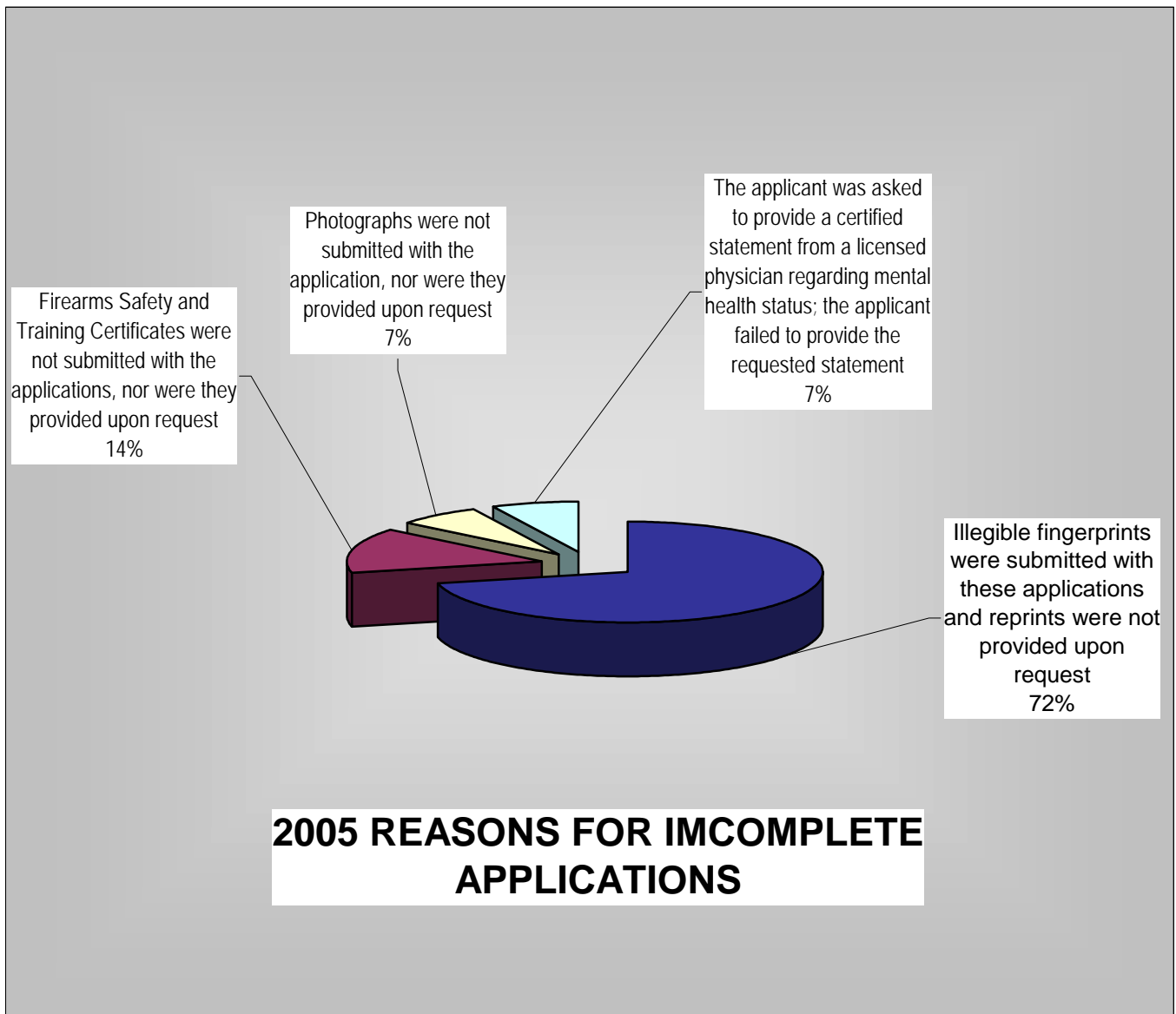

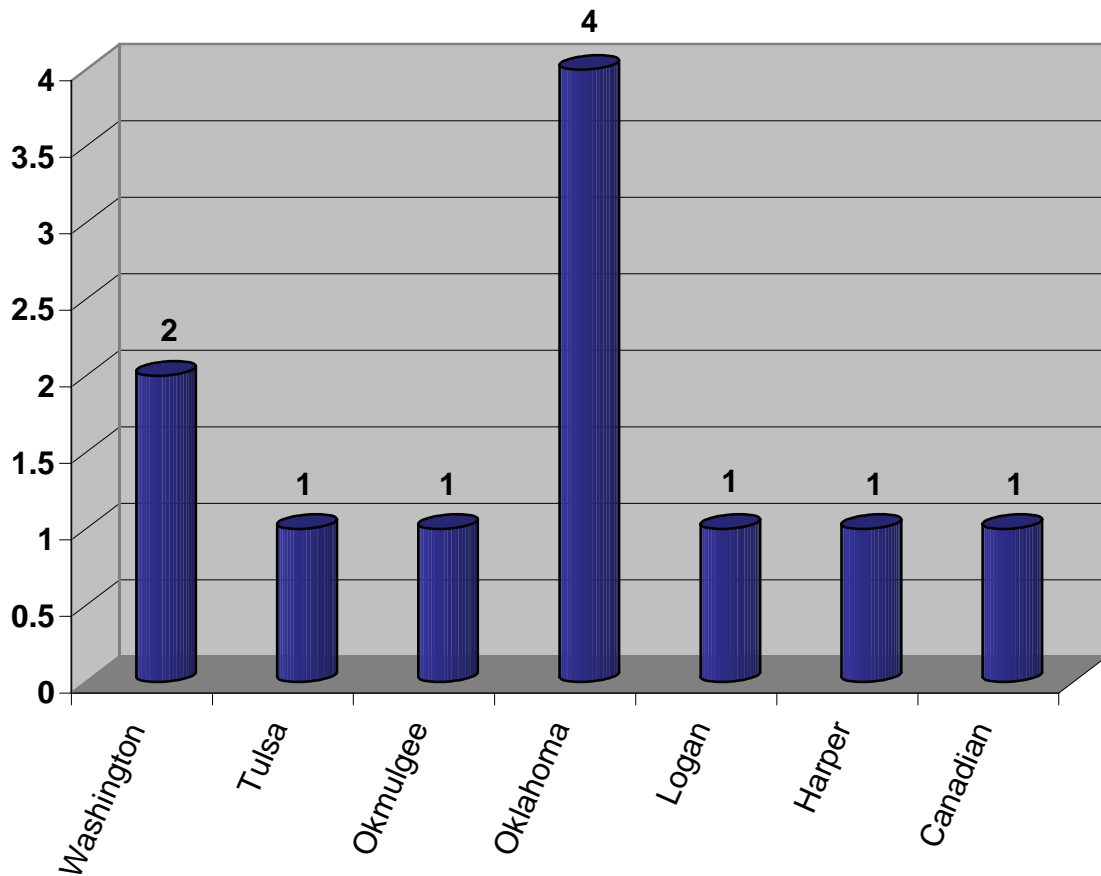
