**2.        STATE OF OKLAHOMA’S CRNA SUPERVISION OPT-OUT LETTER TO CMS**

<p>Dr. Derby moved that the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic Examiners opposes the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) opt-out regarding supervision of Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists (CRNA) and does not consider the decision to be in the best interest of the people of Oklahoma. Dr. Koehler seconded the motion.</p>
