SECOND INTERIM ORDER TABLING APPLICATION

This matter comes on for consideration before the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic Examiners ("Board") at a regular meeting of the Board on June 17, 2021. Caleb Hentges, D.O. ("Dr. Hentges"), an applicant for full licensure, appears in person at the hearing on this date. Dr. Hentges presents without licensed counsel on his Application for full licensure to practice Osteopathic Medicine in the State of Oklahoma. Kevin Klauer, D.O., appeared by Zoom as an advisor for Dr. Hentges.

This Order is issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. § 620 et. seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. § 250 et. seq.

After reviewing Dr. Hentges's Application and hearing sworn testimony, the Board enters this Second Interim Order Tabling Application ("Order"). Future consideration of this Application will occur upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. In order to protect the public, Dr. Hentges shall undergo a psychiatric evaluation by Julio Rojas, Ph.D., or another Board-approved evaluator.
 - a. In order to protect the public, Dr. Hentges shall sign any and all authorizations necessary to release the findings of the psychiatric evaluation directly to the Board.
- 2. In order to protect the public, Dr. Hentges shall obtain a digital copy of the entire audit log showing his access into the electronic medical record system and/or patient charts during his participation in the residency program at Sanford Health in South Dakota for the months of June 2020, July 2020, and August 2020.
 - a. In order to protect the public, Dr. Hentges shall sign any and all authorizations necessary to release the audit information directly to the Board. The Board agrees to keep any identifying patient information confidential and privileged from public disclosure.

- In order to protect the public, Dr. Hentes shall obtain a copy of his work schedule during his participation in the residency program at Sanford Health in South Dakota for the month of July 2020.
- 4. Dr. Hentges's Application shall remain tabled until such time as the Board receives the requested documentation and/or information in this Order.
- 5. Dr. Hentges shall bear the financial costs of any expenses incurred herein, including but not limited to the cost of any hearings, investigations, or evaluations that are ordered or result from the Board's consideration of Dr. Hentges's Application.
- 6. Following receipt of the requested documentation and information, Dr. Hentges will be scheduled to appear before the Board for review of all documents and for any other issues raised by Dr. Hentges's Application and history.
- 7. This Order is not a final determination of this Board and is therefore not appealable as a final order.
- 8. The Board has not reached any final determination in the Application, and nothing in this Order shall guarantee further licensure of Dr. Hentges.
- 9. This Order is a public record and, therefore, subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act.
