The Board, after reviewing the pleadings and the previous Orders, and being fully advised enters this Order of Termination.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Board that, for good cause shown, **TERMINATION** of Dr. O'Hayre's Reciprocal Order of Discipline is **GRANTED**. Any restrictions ordered by the Board on Dr. O'Hayre's license are hereby

removed. Dr. O'Hayre's license to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Oklahoma is restored to the status of good standing without any restrictions or curtailment.

This Order is issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. § 620 *et. seq.* and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. § 250 *et. seq.*

The Board, after reviewing Dr. Page's Affidavit For Surrender of License, and being fully advised enters this Order Accepting Surrender of License. This Surrender of Dr. Page's license is accepted in lieu of investigation. The Board made no decision on the merits of the alleged unprofessional conduct arising out of Arizona.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Board that, for good cause shown, that Dr. Page's Affidavit of Surrender of License has been **ACCEPTED**. Dr. Page is no longer permitted to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Oklahoma.

Further, this Order may be reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank ("NPDB") pursuant to federal law, including but not limited to, 45 CFR Part 60. Moreover, any violation of this Order may result in a referral to the Oklahoma Attorney General for

the unauthorized practice of osteopathic medicine in the State of Oklahoma.

I, Brian S. Page, D.O., the undersigned Licensee (Licensee), after being duly sworn and under oath, do hereby swear or affirm that I am the holder of an Oklahoma license to practice osteopathic medicine (License) issued by the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic Examiners (OSBOE). I am voluntarily submitting this Affidavit for Surrender of License (Affidavit) to cease practicing Osteopathic Medicine in the state of Oklahoma. I request that the Board cancel my license to practice osteopathic medicine in the state of Oklahoma pursuant to Title 59 O.S. § 642. It is understood that my License may be considered for reinstatement upon compliance pursuant to Title 59 O.S. §§ 637, 641, & 642. I acknowledge, upon cancellation, I will no longer be eligible to practice osteopathic medicine in the state of Oklahoma, and further state as follows:

1. I hereby surrender my Oklahoma osteopathic medical license no.: 3339.
2. I hereby surrender my Oklahoma osteopathic medical license effective: , 2022.
3. I acknowledge that the purpose(s) of my request for cancellation in Oklahoma is/are:

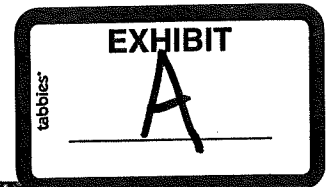
I am surrendering my Oklahoma Osteopathic Medical License because on September 11, 2021, I received a discipline Order from the Arizona Board of Osteopathic Examiners in Medicine and Surgery (AZBOM), case number DO-17-0268A and DO-17-0269A, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order for Decree of Censure, Probation, Practice Restriction, Continuing Education, and Civil Penalty and Consent to Same. AZBOM's Order placed me (Dr. Page) on 5-year probation, Decree of Censure, \$2,000 civil penalty, restrict his practice to charitable organizations and 40 hours of CME. As a result of the Order from AZBOM, the OSBOE opened an investigation on me. OSBOE filed a Complaint against me because of the AZBOM Board Order.

I am further aware and informed that if I seek reapplication of my Oklahoma osteopathic medical license, that the Board has the right to mandate additional requirements, including but not limited to, CME, preceptorship, mentorship, etc., before being granted an Oklahoma Osteopathic Medical License.

I am aware and informed that I have the right to consult legal counsel on this matter and any matter before the Board.

I am aware and informed that nothing in this Affidavit prohibits this document from being a public record and therefore I understand it may be subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act. I am aware and informed that nothing in this Affidavit prohibits this document from being reported to the National Practitioner's Data Bank (NPDB).

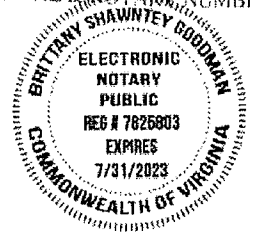
