THIRD INTERIM ORDER WITH TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This matter comes on for consideration before the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic Examiners ("Board") at a regular meeting of the Board on March 16, 2023. Kaylee Davis-Maddy, J.D., counsel for Lisa Baracker, D.O. ("Dr. Baracker") appeared via Teams. Dr. Baracker was not required to appear.

This Third Interim Order with Terms and Conditions ("Third Interim Order") is issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. § 620 et. seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. § 250 et. seq.

The Board, after reviewing Dr. Baracker's previous orders and being fully advised, enters this Third Interim Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Board that Dr. Baracker's license to practice osteopathic medicine remains in effect and is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. That Dr. Baracker's previous order from prior Board Meeting shall remain in effect unless specifically modified by this Third Interim Order.
- 2. That Dr. Baracker is limited to practice only as actively employed in an ACGME-accredited residency program. No moonlighting or other outside practice shall be

permitted during the aforesaid period.

3. That Dr. Baracker is permitted to be assessed through KSTAR in lieu of the

COMVEX examination to provide the Board with information regarding her

competency, knowledge of osteopathic medicine, and other elements of the

profession. The results of which in no way guarantee that restrictions on her

license will be removed or prevent further Board inquiry or investigation.

4. That Dr. Baracker must sign all releases with KSTAR to allow the Board to obtain

records and speak with staff at KSTAR.

5. Following receipt of the results of the examination, Dr. Baracker may request to

appear at the board's next regularly scheduled meeting.

That Dr. Baracker is assessed an ongoing monthly Administrative Maintenance

fee of one hundred dollars (\$100), due on the 1st of each month. The Board has

agreed to stay accruing monthly fees for the time being due to the current

financial burden while Dr. Baracker searches for an ACGME residency and

obtains employment. The monthly fees will resume at a later time once Dr.

Baracker has obtained employment, at which point Dr. Baracker agrees to pay

any fees that have accrued.

7. That Dr. Baracker shall bear the financial costs of any expenses incurred from

this Order.

8. That Dr. Baracker shall ensure all authorizations are signed and completed to

release all reports, documents, etc., directly to the Board.

9. That Dr. Baracker is required to notify the Board within fourteen (14) days of any

changes to her residential or practice address.

10. That Dr. Baracker is required to notify the Board within fourteen (14) days of any changes to her cell phone number.

11. That Dr. Baracker completes the Compliance Information Request Form within ten (10) days of signing this Order. (Exhibit A, Compliance Information Request Form).

12. That Dr. Baracker completes the Monthly Supervision Self-Report by the tenth (10th) day of each month. (Exhibit B, Monthly Supervision Self-Report).

This Order is a public record and therefore subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

Further, This Order may be reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank ("NPDB") pursuant to federal law, including but not limited to, 45 CFR Part 60.

ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for consideration before the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic Examiners ("Board") at the regular meeting of the Board of June 15, 2023. Wilson G. Knight II, DO, Oklahoma License No. 5244 appeared with counsel, Kari Hawthorne. The Board Investigator, Richard Zimmer also appeared and gave testimony.

This Order is pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §620 et seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §250 et seq.

The Board, after reviewing the file and hearing sworn testimony finds the following Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law proven by clear and convincing evidence.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Dr. Knight is a holder of a license to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Oklahoma, License No. 5244.
- 2. That on August 24, 2020 Board filed a complaint against Dr. Knight relating to alleged violations of the Act. Following hearing the Board found by clear and convincing evidence that Dr. Knight had violated the Act, specifically 59 O.S. 2021, §637(A)(2)(f) and (A)(6).
- 3. Subsequently Dr. Knight's license No. 5244 was placed on three-year term of probation in December, 2021 under enumerated terms and conditions.
- 4. That evidence showed since probation was imposed Dr. Knight underwent evaluation by Dr. Beaman and Dr. Beaman supports termination of Dr. Knight's probation and evidence showed Dr. Knight was successful in affiliation and monitoring with the Oklahoma Health Professional Program (OHPP) and that Dr. Knight had fulfilled and was in compliance with all terms and conditions of the OHPP contract.
- 5. That Dr. Knight complied with all terms and conditions of his probation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §620 et seq., rules for the Board 510 OAC §1-1 et seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §250 et seq.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board Dr. Knight's period of probation should be and is hereby terminated based on his successful completion thereof.

FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER OF REVOCATION

This matter comes on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic Examiners ("Board") at a regular meeting of the Board on March 16, 2023. The Board is represented by Chief Prosecutor for the Board, Michael T. Leake Jr., J.D. Melvin L. Robison, D.O. ("Dr. Robison") was provided notice for the hearing but is currently in federal prison and did not appear. The Board's Chief Investigator, Richard Zimmer, appeared and gave sworn testimony.

This Order is issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, Tit. 59 O.S. § 620 *et seq.* and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, Tit. 75 O.S. § 250 *et. seq.*

The Board, after reviewing the pleadings and testimony at the hearing and otherwise considering all of the evidence and being fully advised, specifically finds the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law to be true and correct and proven by clear and convincing evidence:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Dr. Robison is the holder of a license to practice as an osteopathic physician

in the State of Oklahoma, license number 2832.

2. Proper notice of this hearing was served on Dr. Robison as required by

Oklahoma law.

3. Evidence at the March 16, 2023, hearing before the Board revealed that Dr.

Robison entered two (2) guilty pleas related to 164 counts of illegal distribution of

controlled drugs in the case known as CR 18-163, Western District of Oklahoma Federal

Court. Additionally, Dr. Robison pled guilty to one felony count of Medicare fraud out of

the Southern District of Florida Federal Court in the case known as CR 21-219. As a result

of Dr. Robison's guilty pleas, he received a total of 54 months of confinement in federal

prison followed by three (3) years of supervised release and payment to the Federal

Government of more than \$300,000 in restitution and fines.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to Oklahoma

Osteopathic Medicine Act, Tit. 59 O.S. § 620 et seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative

Procedures Act, Tit. 75 O.S. § 250 et. seq.

2. The Board concludes, by clear and convincing evidence, that Dr. Robison

is in violation of Tit. 59 O.S. § 637(A)(2), (A)(2)(c), (A)(2)(d), (A)(2)(g), (A)(5), (A)(6), and

(A)(7).

3. The Board concludes by clear and convincing evidence that such violations

are grounds for imposing any sanction against Dr. Robison's license to practice

osteopathic medicine in the state of Oklahoma that is permitted by statute and the rules

and regulations of the Board.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Board that

the license to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Oklahoma held by Dr. Robison

is hereby REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order is to be disseminated to all related

regulatory agencies as well as to all hospitals, pharmacies, and related entities in the area

where Dr. Robison formerly practiced medicine.

This Order is a public record and therefore subject to the Oklahoma Open Records

Act.

Further, This Order may be reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank

("NPDB") pursuant to federal law, including but not limited to, 45 CFR Part 60.

Moreover, any violation of this Order may result in a referral to the Oklahoma

FINAL ORDER OF PUBLIC REPRIMAND

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic Examiners ("Board") en banc at the meeting of March 16, 2023. Petitioner appeared by and through legal counsel Bayleigh Adams. Respondent Dr. Stephens appeared in person and by legal counsel Shar Agosto, attorney, Owasso, Oklahoma.

Whereupon witnesses were sworn and gave testimony and exhibits were introduced into admission and respective legal counsel made closing arguments.

Whereupon the Board, en banc being fully advised in the premises and having reviewed all pleadings, evidence and argument of counsel makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Dr. Linh Stephens, D.O., is the holder of a license to practice as an osteopathic physician in the State of Oklahoma, license number 5127.
- 2. Dr. Stephens is in violation of the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §626(D) and §637(A)(7) and (A)(11) which state:
 - "D. Any licensee or applicant for license subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act shall be deemed to have given consent to any duly authorized employee or agent of the Board to access, enter, or inspect, the records, either on site or at the Board office, or facilities of such licensee or applicant subject to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act. Refusal to allow such access, entry, or inspection may constitute grounds for the denial, non-renewal, suspension, or revocation of a license."

"Section 637

A. The State Board of Osteopathic Examiners may.... suspend or revoke any license issued or reinstated by the Board upon proof that the applicant or holder of such a license:

- 7. Has violated or failed to comply with provisions of any act or regulation administered by the Board.
- 11. Has violated or refused to comply with the lawful order of the Board."
- 3. On February 2, 2023, Dr. Stephens agreed to meet with Board Executive Director Michael Leake and Investigator Richard Zimmer at her office at 2:00 p.m. on February 7, 2023.

4. Later on February 2, 2023, Dr. Stephens declined and refused to meet with the Board Executive Director Michael Leake and the Board Investigator. Dr. Stephens' email provided in pertinent part:

"Good afternoon,

My clinic is for my patients and you guys are all NOT my patients, and expect to address my complaints against Stephen E. Hale for practicing medicine without a license at YOUR office, which I assume you have a Tulsa branch somewhere in (the) Tandy Building (OSU) downtown! Any disclosures and possible conflict of interests with the person I was complaining about?

I have other priorities and to-dos, and I don't want to have a meeting with just TWO lawyers and then having to repeat myself the same story to the rest of the medical board. I do NOT want you or anyone to speak about my complaints to the WHOLE medical board (including doctors, and citizens who are not doctors nor lawyers) on my behalf because I want to do it MYSELF to the whole medical board, so no one can twist my words or put words into my mouth." (Capitals in the original).

5. Later still on February 2, 2023, Mr. Leake responded to Dr. Stephens by email, to-wit:

"I am the Executive Director of the DO Board—the DO Boar oversees your license to practice osteopathic medicine in Oklahoma and is also the office where you filed your complaint on the GAL attorney alleging the unauthorized practice of medicine. Are you asking to appear before the DO Board to talk to the whole Board about your complaint on Mr. Hale? The DO Board does have osteopathic doctors on it. If so, I'm happy to put you on the agenda. Lastly, I would still like to meet with you to discuss your arrest from last year. I am happy to arrange a meeting following your court hearing on February 14th in Tulsa County. Of course, you are welcome to bring a lawyer to this meeting. Many thanks.

Michael Leake"

- Dr. Stephens did not reschedule the informal meeting requested by Mr.
 Leake and Investigator Zimmer.
- 7. On February 14, 2023, Dr. Stephens sent the below email to Mr. Leake and Mr. Zimmer, to-wit:

"I do want to have a meeting in front of the whole medical board (with doctors, and normal civilians as well) NEXT WEEK. For emphasis, with everyone on the medical board (not just lawyers like yourselves who are friends with Stephen E. Hale per your undertone underhanded threats of retaliation against my medical license in email as attached below despite I'm the whistleblower); my criminal defense lawyer will be there also, where I am a victim reporting crime committed by Stephen E. Hale (a lawyer like yourself) practicing medicine WITHOUT any medical license, and THEN & THERE while in front of the whole board (with doctors and civilians non-lawyers) feel free to ask about false retaliation protective order against me (80 pounds Asian American female) by a 220 plus pounds angry white male (same race and gender as you both). This has not been adjudicated at all nor charged at all followed by my abusive ex-husband's perjurious false VPO--I wasn't served properly with VPO either.

My criminal defense attorney and I do NOT agree to meet you two biased lawyers outside of whole medical board, as you have NEVER denied IN WRITING your conflict of interest with Stephen E. Hale and his law firm--who practice medicine without a license by declaring multiple mothers in Oklahoma "crazy" or other made up diagnosis with required treatment of their children to never to see their mothers again, while the truly mentally-ill father who was already-diagnosed by numerous licensed doctors was MISDIAGNOSED (again without a medical license) by Stephen E. Hale as 'not mentally ill, no need for psyche eval, very fit father and recommended child(ren) taken away from currently safe, fit mother, while bypassing material safe/fit grandparents or extended safe relatives and close family friends, but given directly to abusive plus/minus mentally-ill fathers to abuse the children 24/7.'

Please coordinate the schedule if my lawyer Shar, whose email is in the CC."

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §620 et seq.
- 2. The aforesaid evidence shows clear and convincing evidence that the Respondent violated 59 O.S. 2021, §626(D) which provides in pertinent part:
 - "D. Any licensee or applicant for license subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act shall be deemed to have given consent to any duly authorized employee or agent of the Board to access, enter, or inspect, the records, either on site or at the Board office, or facilities of such licensee or applicant subject to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act. Refusal to allow such access, entry, or inspection may constitute grounds for the denial, non-renewal, suspension, or revocation of a license."
- 3. The evidence shows clear and convincing evidence that the Respondent violated 59 O.S. 2021, §637(A)(7) and (A)(11) which provide as follows:

"Section 637

- A. The State Board of Osteopathic Examiners may. suspend or revoke any license issued or reinstated by the Board upon proof that the applicant or holder of such a license:
 - 7. Has violated or failed to comply with provisions of any act or regulation administered by the Board.
 - 11. Has violated or refused to comply with the lawful order of the Board."

4. Based on those violations of the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act the Board has power to impose a sanction within its discretion pursuant to legal authority of 59 O.S. 2021, §637.1(3).

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that in this cause the Respondent receive a public reprimand and admonition.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board General Counsel was directed to instanter publicly reprimand the Respondent on the violations set forth above, and that any other member of the Board may also make whatever comments to Dr. Stephens on the record they feel appropriate.

After reviewing Dr. Thomas' compliance with his previous Board Orders entered wherein terms of probation were placed on his Oklahoma Osteopathic medical license; the Board now terminates his probation as set forth below.

ORDER

- 5. Any violation of this Order may result in further discipline of Dr. Thomas' license to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Oklahoma.

This Order is a public record and therefore subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

Further, This Order may be reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank ("NPDB") pursuant to federal law, including but not limited to, 45 CFR Part 60.
