ORDER TO TABLE APPLICATION PENDING RECEIPT OF ADDITIONAL EVIDENCE

This matter came on for consideration before the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic Examiners ("Board") at the regular meeting of the Board of June 15, 2023. Applicant Dr. Douglas B. Morris, DO appeared in person.

This Order is pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §620 et seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §250 et seq.

The Board, after reviewing Dr. Morris' application for reinstatement of license and hearing sworn testimony finds the following Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law proven by clear and convincing evidence.

- 1. Dr. Morris previously held Oklahoma osteopathic license No. 4263.
- 2. Dr. Morris practiced in the area of vascular surgery from approximately 2002 to 2017.
 - 3. Dr. Morris' last continuing medical education was completed in 2018.

- 4. Dr. Morris was diagnosed with Type 2 diabetes, and then with Type 1 diabetes and has been in AA since 2013 and attends approximately 4 AA meetings per week. Dr. Morris is currently in therapy and attends approximately 3 times per month.
- 5. Dr. Morris has not had any formal assessment of his clinical skills or fitness to practice since his original licensure, and Dr. Morris had not yet become affiliated with the Oklahoma Health Practitioner Program (OHPP).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §620 et seq., rules for the Board 510 OAC §1-1 et seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §250 et seq.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board that Dr. Morris' application to reissue Oklahoma Osteopathic Medical License No. 4263 should be and is hereby tabled until Dr. Morris provides the Board with evidence of the following, to-wit:

- 1. An assessment of clinical skills and fitness to practice conducted by a testing facility acceptable to the Board.
- 2. Provide evidence that Dr. Morris has affiliated with OHPP and is under active monitoring by OHPP and in good standing with their protocols.
- 3. This Order does not guarantee that Oklahoma Osteopathic Medical License No. 4263 will be reissued to Dr. Morris but the

Board will consider again Dr. Morris' application upon completion of conditions set forth above.

- 4. That Dr. Morris shall bear the financial costs of any expenses incurred from this Order.
- 5. That Dr. Morris shall ensure that all authorizations to release all records, reports, documents and attachments directly to the Board are signed and completed.
- 6. This Order is a public record and therefore subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act. Further this Order may be reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB) pursuant to federal law, including but not limited to, 45 C.F.R. Part 60.

ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE WITH CONDITIONS

This matter comes on for consideration before the Oklahoma State Board of Osteopathic Examiners ("Board") at its regular meeting of the Board held on June 15, 2023. Applicant Dr. Junaid Alam, DO appeared by video along with his legal counsel, Neel Natarajan, by video.

This Order is pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §620 et seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §250 et seq.

The Board, after reviewing the application file, hearing testimony and being fully advised specifically finds the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law to be proven by clear and convincing evidence.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Dr. Junaid Alam is an applicant for license to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Oklahoma.

- 2. That since approximately August, 2015 the applicant was involved in allegations of domestic violence with a former girlfriend and in February, 2021 with his spouse and any criminal cases were subsequently dismissed and expunged.
- 3. That the applicant is not currently in any counseling and the applicant did successfully complete 36-hours of intensive counseling on or around May 19, 2021.
- 4. That the applicant meets the requirements for licensure in Oklahoma as an osteopathic physician with certain conditions.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §620 et seq., rules for the Board 510 OAC §1-1 et seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §250 et seq.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board that Dr. Alam's application for license to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Oklahoma should be granted subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Dr. Alam shall present evidence of initial assessment by an appropriate professional approved by the Board on the topics of anger management, disruptive physician, and domestic abuse and monthly reports from a professional following up on that evaluation shall be presented directly to the Board staff.
- 2. That the Board en banc will review the aforesaid reports at its meeting of December, 2023 and consider any subsequent

evidence and enter any further Order as supported by evidence presented at that time.

- 3. That Dr. Alam shall bear the financial costs of any evaluation and any periodic reports made to the Oklahoma Board.
- 4. That Dr. Alam shall ensure all authorizations to release all evaluation reports, attachments and documents directly to the Oklahoma Board.
- 5. This Order is a public record and therefore subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act. Further, this Order may be reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank ("NPDB") pursuant to federal law, including but not limited to, 45 C.F.R. Part 60.

The Board, after reviewing the application file, hearing sworn testimony and being fully advised specifically finds the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law to be proven by clear and convincing evidence.

- 1. Dr. Gaskins held Oklahoma Osteopathic Medical License No. 7670 and now seeks renewal of that license.
- 2. That Dr. Gaskins originally received training license in July, 2022 but resigned from his training program on or around January 3, 2023.

- 3. That Dr. Gaskins sought and received treatment for anxiety and that treatment continues with daily medication now supervised by his primary care physician Dr. Leslie Edelman.
- 4. That a review of records indicates Dr. Gaskins never completed one-year rotating internship and specifically did not complete rotations in pediatrics or in OB/GYN.
- 5. That Dr. Gaskins would require training license to complete rotating internship in pediatrics and OB/GYN at an ACGME approved program.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §620 et seq., rules for the Board 510 OAC §1-1 et seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §250 et seq.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board that Dr. Gaskins' Oklahoma Osteopathic Medical License No. 7670 be tabled pending his successful completion of the following conditions.

- 2. That upon successful completion of those two rotating internships, then Dr. Gaskins' Oklahoma Osteopathic License No. 7670 may be reinstated by operation of the Board staff.

- 3. That Dr. Gaskins be issued training license instanter for the specific purpose of completing the two rotating internships named above.
- 4. That Dr. Gaskins shall bear the financial costs of any expenses incurred from this Order.
- 5. That Dr. Gaskins shall ensure all records and reports of his rotating internships in pediatrics and OB/GYN be provided directly to the Board staff.
- 6. This Order is a public record and therefore subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act. Further, this Order may be reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank ("NPDB") pursuant to federal law, including but not limited to, 45 C.F.R. Part 60.

- 2. Dr. Grubbs PGY1 rotations began August 1, 2018, but she discontinued same based on personal health challenges.

3. That Dr. Grubbs does meet the requirements for issuance of a training license by the Oklahoma Board of Osteopathic Examiners and said license should be issued under certain conditions.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board, after reviewing the file and hearing sworn testimony finds the following Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law proven by clear and convincing evidence.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Dr. Knight is a holder of a license to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Oklahoma, License No. 5244.
- 2. That on August 24, 2020 Board filed a complaint against Dr. Knight relating to alleged violations of the Act. Following hearing the Board found by clear and convincing evidence that Dr. Knight had violated the Act, specifically 59 O.S. 2021, §637(A)(2)(f) and (A)(6).
- 3. Subsequently Dr. Knight's license No. 5244 was placed on three-year term of probation in December, 2021 under enumerated terms and conditions.
- 4. That evidence showed since probation was imposed Dr. Knight underwent evaluation by Dr. Beaman and Dr. Beaman supports termination of Dr. Knight's probation and evidence showed Dr. Knight was successful in affiliation and monitoring with the Oklahoma Health Professional Program (OHPP) and that Dr. Knight had fulfilled and was in compliance with all terms and conditions of the OHPP contract.
- 5. That Dr. Knight complied with all terms and conditions of his probation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act, 59 O.S. 2021, §620 et seq., rules for the Board 510 OAC §1-1 et seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §250 et seq.
