All data retention is managed in conjunction with the [Oklahoma State Department of Libraries](#), according to its [Records Retention Schedule](#), under the Records Management Act [Title 67 O.S. § 201, et seq.](#), with the guidance and authority of the state Archives and Record Commission, pursuant to [Title 67 O.S. § 305, et seq.](#), and applicable Federal Law.
