Budget Update

- Sovereign will have \$106,700 carry over for the 2021-2022 school year.
- July 1, 2021 will begin year 2 of our lease with KLS II. All rent payments are 100% applied to the principal. KLS II is a short term 0% financier. The option to buy outright at the end year 5 is both of our goals.
- Once we reach year 4, we begin the purchasing process, 2023-2024 school year.
- PPP loan forgiveness will be processed in August 2021.
