

SBE Possible Action on 2025 Proposed Administrative Rules

If agency receives written and/or oral public comment, agency reviews comments and may proceed with the rulemaking process pursuant to one of the following:

___ i. Agency revises proposed rules in response to comments and proceeds to adoption. See Title 75 O.S. §§ 251, 303, 303.1.

Note: A summary of the comments received by the agency, as well as an "explanation of changes or lack of any change made in the adopted rules as a result of testimony received at all hearings or meetings held" must be identified in the Agency Rule Report as required by Title 75 O.S. § 303.1(E)(9).

- OR -

___ ii. Agency revises proposed rules in response to comments, but determines that additional public comment on proposed revisions should be solicited. Agency must provide for a new comment period of at least 30 days. See Title 75 O.S. §§ 251, 303, 303.1.

Note: Pursuant to Title 75 O.S. § 303, "[f]or at least thirty (30) days after publication of the notice of the intended rulemaking action, afford a comment period for all interested persons to submit data, views or arguments, orally or in writing. The agency shall consider fully all written and oral submissions respecting the proposed rule..."

- OR -

___ iii. Agency does not revise proposed rules in response to comments, and determines to continue with rules as proposed. See Title 75 O.S. §§ 251, 303, 303.1.

Note: A summary of the comments received by the agency, as well as an "explanation of changes or lack of any change made in the adopted rules as a result of testimony received at all hearings or meetings held" must be identified in the Agency Rule Report as required by Title 75 O.S. § 303.1(E)(9).

___ iv. Agency discontinues rulemaking action. See Title 75 O.S. §§ 251, 303, 303.1.
