Pursuant to Title 70 O.S. §§ 11-103.6, 11-103.6a, and 11-103.6a-1, the State Board of Education shall adopt subject matter standards for instruction of students in the public schools of this state that are necessary to ensure there is attainment of desired levels of competencies in a variety of areas. The subject matter standards shall be thoroughly reviewed by the State Board every six (6) years. Upon adoption of any subject matter standards, the State Board of Education shall submit the adopted standards to the Speaker of the House of Representatives or a designee and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate or a designee prior to the last thirty (30) days of the legislative session. The standards shall not be implemented by the State Board of Education until the legislative review process is completed.

8. Emergency (Provisional) Teacher Certification

Discussion and possible action on requests for exceptions to the State Board of Education teacher certification regulations to permit emergency (provisional) certificates. **70 O.S. § 6-187(G):**

Under 70 O.S. § 6-187(G), “nothing in the Oklahoma Teacher Preparation Act shall restrict the right of the State Board of Education to issue an emergency or provisional certificate.” However, prior to requesting an emergency or provisional certificate, the schools district is required to “document substantial efforts to employ a teacher who holds a provisional or standard certificate.” *Id.* If the district is unable to do so, the district must then “document efforts to employ an individual with a provisional or standard certificate in another area” that also has “academic preparation in the field of need.” *Id.* In other words, only after exhausting both of these options is a district permitted to request an emergency or provisional certification.
