Please accept this letter as notification that Mount Saint Mary Catholic High School intends to participate in the Lindsey Nicole Henry Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program. The Mount is located in Oklahoma City, OK, and we serve students in grades 9-12.

Before accepting a student with disabilities, The Mount interviews the student and his/her parents or legal guardian to insure that the services we provide can best serve the student with disabilities both academically and socially. In addition, we review all official documentation provided by the parent or legal guardian and/or the transferring school such as IEPs, test scores, evaluations by medical and special service professionals, etc. to insure that we are aware of the student's needs. Students with disabilities who are served by Mount Saint Mary are serviced in our PLUSS (Providing the Link to Unlimited Student Success), which is a separate class taught by a certified special-ed teacher. Our specially trained teacher not only works with the students and their needs, but she also collaborates with the teachers, providing them what they may need as they make modifications for each of their PLUSS students.

Mount Saint Mary Catholic High School has been educating students since 1903. The school is fully accredited by the OK State Department of Education and has received a "no deficiency status" for the last consecutive six years. We are in compliance with the antidiscrimination provision of 42 U.S.C., Section 2000d; we meet state and local health and safety laws and codes; we will be academically accountable to the parent or legal guardian for meeting educational needs of the students; we employ only certified teachers who hold baccalaureate or higher degrees; we comply with all state laws relating to general regulation of private schools; and we will adhere to the tenets of our published disciplinary procedures prior to the expulsion of a student.
